Introductions/Announcements

Proposed Events & Projects:

Theme: I am planning on theming this as “A German Twelfth Night.” (“Dreikönigsfest” in German, not that we need to use that) Feast, decorations, tournaments, heraldry, and more can follow the theme.

Children’s Activities/Scavenger Hunt: Mistress Rosanore of Redthorn (, (651) 699-0714) will be planning and running a scavenger hunt again this year, and possibly other children’s activities.

Heavy and Rapier Tourney: Anpliça and I are working on an idea for a (German-themed) heraldic tournament for both heavy and rapier, in which each fighter would be represented by a herald, who needs to answer pop quiz-style questions to gain their fighter a benefit, and not give them a penalty (such as no off-hand weapon/shield, etc., using offhand for main weapon, etc.) by answering incorrectly. Schticky and fun for fighters and heralds alike. Prizes could be themed with German heraldry.

Feast: German style feast, possibly with dessert including mini Three Kings cakes, one of which includes an almond to be found by one person in their cake— the recipient becomes Twelfth Night King or Queen for the evening per German (and many European) tradition(s); could join the royalty if that’s permissible.

Gambling Tournament Fundraiser: Bastien is planning and running a gambling tournament as a fundraiser for baronial armor.

A&S Competition: Prizes from Fire Mountain, SR Harris, etc.

Bard of Nordskogen Contest

Bardic Circle: Open Bardic Circle during the day in the Sanctuary.

Raffle: Khadjiah has volunteered to run this, with a “Suggested Donation” amount for tickets so we don’t need to apply for licensing.

Site Tokens: Per German tradition, Twelfth Night/Dreikönigsfest tends to remember the three Magi. As a callback to this (and the star they followed), I would like to have a simple star painted on a wooden token, or stamped on a metal token, to be hung from a ribbon.

Sternsingern (“Star Singers”): Jara choir will have a sort of caroling or similar “traveling” (around the main hall) performance of period/German music (some sung in English, perhaps), as with the German Twelfth Night tradition of Sternsingern. I have spoken with Jose São Pacian (ltopera@yahoo.com) about this.

Northshield Choir Rehearsal: Will be on the schedule.

BARONIAL CANDIDATES' QUESTIONNAIRES AND SCA RESUMES

Bazyli and Siobhan

Baronial Candidate Questionnaire Nordskogen 2016

1. What is your idea of the role of the Baronage?

The Baron and Baroness are leaders, cheerleaders, inspirations, and stewards for the Barony. They should work well with the traditional officer structure as well as with the various activities within the Barony.

- a. How should the Baronage interact with the various martial activities?
If not actively part of the martial communities, the Baron and Baroness should understand the basics of each martial activity, be a sponsor and cheerleader for the activity, and stay in close contact with the marshals for each activity. For example, we'd like to see the Yetis revived and have the awarding of Baronial fighting favors be part of the Wednesday night Folk Moot every month.
- b. How should the Baronage interact with the arts & science activities?
Similarly to the martial activities, the Baron and Baroness should work closely with the Arts leaders in the group (MOAS as well as small group activities) and help inspire not only individual activities but group activities. For example, using various arts to create Baronial panoply (Banners, tabards, tablecloths, etc.) can be a good use of the creative spirits in the Barony. On the other hand, the recent move to make circlets for the AOA recipients is another example of using the arts to benefit others.
- c. What kind of role should the Baronage have in service activities?
The Baron and Baroness should seek out and lead the Barony in performing service activities. For example, creating Gulf Wars favors or event tokens for WW could be service activities that the Barony could perform. Working with the Royal Family would be a strong way to find out about needs the Kingdom has that the Barony might be able to fill.
- d. How should the Baronage interact with the Baronial Officers?
The Baron and Baroness should know the reporting schedules and know whether or not each officer is reporting on time and performing their duties as prescribed in the job description. The Barons are part of the "hiring committee" when we are lucky enough to have more than one candidate for jobs, and to reach out and locate talent for positions when they come open. While the Baronial Officers do not report to the Baron and Baroness, they must know what's in the reports going to Kingdom and be able to help, if possible, with issues impacting each office.
- e. How should the Baronage interact with its satellite groups (Nordleigh, Blachemere, ARCC)?
The Baron and Baroness should show up at Business meetings in the satellite groups, and moots or other informal events that are held. If the satellite groups are sponsoring an event, the Baron and Baroness should be first to offer help and assistance and cheerlead the teams from each satellite group. They should grease the way (should assistance be needed) between each group so that relationships stay cordial and helpful.
- f. How should the Baronage interact with the Royal family of Northshield?
The Baron and Baroness hold the welfare of the Barony and its inhabitants in fief to the Kingdom. They should be open and available to the Royalty, as well as communicating with them in the manner the Royalty wishes, to make known the welfare and service opportunities the Barony can provide. The Baron and Baroness serve as advisors to the Royal Family, as needed. As well, the Barony should consult with the Royal Family and pay taxes that will assist them in gifting appropriately to other Kingdoms or at other events. For example, when the Royalty are assigned another Kingdom for a gift basket at major events, the Barony should contribute to that gift.

- b. Describe your experience with royalty, royal peers, and royal protocol.

Siobhan: I have been a member of the Curia, advising the royalty. As a peer of the realm, it is my job to advise and confer with the current Royalty both formally in meetings and informally when an issue arises. I have been a member of the entourage for Regional Princes and Princesses in the West as well as Royal Entourages, and have taken my turn as retinue for various Kings, Queens, Princes, and Princesses. I have respect for royal protocol and attempt to both exemplify respect for royals and teach appropriate protocol to my household members.

Bazyli: I have to be honest here, though I'm a kingdom officer, I have not had much experience conferring with royalty in an official context. I have had the good fortune to have conversations with current and previous royal peers, and can count a few of them as friends. I've retained at events for royals and have found it a wonderful experience. As Baron, I would have to rely on Siobhan's greater experience to guide me through the first few interactions, until I got my feet under me. However, I have tons of experience at learning as I go along.

3. Will your modern life permit you to attend Baronial/Canton/College meetings and events on a regular basis?

Siobhan: Yes, with the caveat that I have some chronic illnesses and a job that occasionally has overtime that affect my ability to do things on a random basis. For example, back pain or a migraine sometimes affects my schedule. However, the good thing about having two people who are not living together as Baron and Baroness is that our lives do not necessarily affect one another, and we can step up to cover for the other when needed.

Bazyli: Yes. I have attended most of the Baronial events and several of the Canton ones as well since becoming active in Nordskogen. Since becoming Chatelain I have attended almost all of our Wednesday night meetings and all of the business meetings. I would happily attend the Canton meetings as well.

- a. What sort of plans do you have in your modern life over the next few years?

Siobhan: update my house, keep my job, travel to England in 2017, visit my family across the US.

Bazyli: I am currently in a stable job and plan on keeping it for the foreseeable future. My Lady and I are planning a vacation to Venice, Italy inside the next two years, in March of either 2017 or 2018, which may affect us going to Gulf Wars that year.

- b. Do you have the resources to support a multi-year reign?

Yes.

- c. Do you have a network of staff/volunteers to assist with your reign? What type of discussion(s) have you had with this group?

Siobhan's household and loose affiliation with Gnomeworld, as well as Bazyli's association with several other households such as Temple Rose, should help us keep on top of things without burning out any particular group or person. So far, these groups have been uniformly positive about supporting us in the reign. In addition, we have had conversations with the other candidates and all see supporting the ones eventually chosen as part of our responsibilities to the Barony.

4. Where do you see the Barony in 5 years?

We would like to see the Barony grow by 50% in the next five years, and have the current depth of arts and sciences interests among our people grow to become Guilds or Associations for those interests. Regularly established activities and people doing them help absorb new people more easily and assist with recruiting. For example, the Rumpstilskein fiber arts group has brought in many new people, some of whom have also expanded their activities to include mainstream life in the Barony. Her Grace Petranella's Monday night sewing open house has put clothes on the backs of many newcomers.

- a. What sort of plans/projects do you intend to implement during your reign?

- We would like to reach out to the 100 some members that don't come to meetings (Baronial or Canton) to see if there is anything that we could develop that they would like to be active in. Among other things, we would like to see our heavy fighters more integrated in the life of the rest of the Barony.
- Dance practice: Lady Isabetta started this a few months ago, and we fully intend to continue to support it.
- Choir: Dame Siobhan would like to see a choir formed, and is willing to lead it.
- A&S classes: We wish to increase the visibility of the Arts and Sciences. In that, we will be seeking out members of the barony that specialize in various arts and bring them in for hands on classes. Examples would be silk banners, tents, and leather working. Of note, we would also like to see regular workshops for newcomers that actually end up with clothes on their backs. Further, we wish to have more displays at moots and events.
- Siege weapons and thrown weapons: We love both of these, and will figure out how to do more and spread the joy.
- Our archers give us wordfame throughout the Known Worlde, and we want to continue to support their growth and prowess. We would seek their advice on items such as participation in IKAC events, forming a Baronial Cohort, or whatever they think will improve their cohesion.
- We would like to promote more personal and Baronial pageantry at events and the moots. Holding Court at Moots, giving our new fighters and archers their favors or Nordcords, perhaps giving out more local awards are all ways we see to increase interest and attendance at the folk moots. Commissioning a Baronial Pennant similar to the one Silfren Mere had at Castle Fever would increase our Baronial visibility on the field and in peaceful settings.

- b. What are your thoughts on recruiting and keeping new members?
Recruiting is a subject that comes up often in the SCA. For that matter, all volunteer organizations struggle with this subject. We feel that our best recruiting tool is the good word of our deeds. Word of mouth is a powerful force, if a slow one. It is also very hard to quantify or fit into a recruiting campaign. We feel that increasing public awareness that the Barony exist is a good use of time and resources. For instance, we could simply walk down Nicollet mall in garb and hand out business cards. It harkens back to the first event. Another idea is a bumper sticker campaign, with variations to window clings and magnetic decals.

That being said, we need to proceed carefully with recruitment, as there are only so many new people we are prepared to introduce to our community at a time. If we gotten new people a week, we would be lucky to retain one as the rest would not get the attention they deserve to be integrated to where their interests and feelings lie.

- c. What are your thoughts on the volunteer burnout rate in Nordskogen?
Burnout is a sad but common part of any volunteer organization. One way to mitigate burnout is for the leadership to keep clear lines of communication with the officers and regular members of event staffs. Another way is the increase the mentoring of new members. Duchess Petranella and Baroness Ivetta mentored Bazyli through his first few events. Similarly, Siobhan was mentored in the ways of Nordskogen by Samia and Oswald. This is a wonderful model that both increases the pool of experienced people and shares the knowledge of the Barony.

In addition, those people with needed skills (event stewardship, feast stewardship, gate, etc.) should be actively taking on new people and teaching them the ropes to expand our pool of talent. If we have bench strength, we have less burnout.

- d. What value do traditions have to the group? What are your thoughts on bringing back old ones, and/or strengthening existing ones and/or creating new ones?
Traditions are awesome. They weave the past into the present to enrich the future. That being said, we both feel that we're still learning the traditions of Nordskogen. The 40th Anniversary projects helped show all the group some of the rich tapestry that is the Barony.

The Barony has 40 years' experience under our belts, and has changed and adapted over the years. We feel that we should unearth some of those traditions of the past for our present day activities. At the same time, we feel it's completely appropriate to adapt traditions of the past (SCA and historical alike) to increase our celebration of history.

For example, a scholar in Æthelmarc is researching pageantry and traditional feast menus that go with 14th C Archery tournaments. We could adopt some of his learnings into our regular Schutzenfest event.

5. How should Nordskogen interact with our neighboring Shires/Baronies?

At first glance, one might think that we, being the largest group in Northshield, should export out our amazingness to all the smaller groups of our kingdom. But that's just not true. A great example is our dance practice group, where members from Silfren Mere and Jararvellir are coming here to participate and teach. There are people of such amazing skill and knowledge in our kingdom, and we would like to encourage the sharing of that pool of talent. Whether it be dancing or woodworking, arrow making or gold key collecting, we should find these individuals and find ways to get to them or get them to come to us so that we can, in the modern parlance, geek out together.

Samia, the MOAS, is working on workshops with folks from other parts of the Kingdom. We support those efforts wholeheartedly and would like to see those efforts continue.

- a. How should Nordskogen interact with the Kingdom? (volunteers/finances/physical resources)

When called upon we should contribute our funds as required (see the example of the SCA lawsuit settlement, for example). Our folks are strongly connected to the life of the Kingdom through our strong

and significant membership in orders such as the Tyr, Black Griffins, Aquila, Bridget's Flame, etc., as well as our many Peers. Our Barony volunteers provide the Aquila hoods, the collars for the MODs, as well as other regalia on a regular basis. We share our pavilion and Sunshades, as well as our Archery equipment and loaner gear. These are appropriate and should continue.

6. What personal associations (household(s), dependent relationships, etc.) do you have and what effect will they have on you being the Baronage? What effects will the Baronage have on them?

Siobhan's household, Cinqfoil, has several members among the Barony and Kingdom, and consist of her peerage dependents and "friends" of the household. It meshes into House Wortham with the overlap of several members. We can see only positive effect from these connections, as they provide a deep pool of talent and several current and former officers and Barons/Baronesses of the Barony in their number, giving us resources to call on for activities and guidance.

At the same time, Bazyli is a "friend" of both House Cinqfoil and Temple Rose, which provides overlap into that group of experience and talent.

No doubt we will call on them for guidance and assistance. They have promised to say "no" whenever a request is beyond their skill, resources, or would overcommit them, or impinge improperly on their personal lives. As all the folks in all these group are frank and honest in our relationships with them, we can expect no less than the truth from them.

We should be working with the martial arts communities (armored, rapier, archery, thrown weapons, equestrian) to listen to how we can help with their activities and promote them to the all levels of the Society. We will take on the traditional and strong practices of special tournaments and court champions, and we will invite other initiatives of support from the populace.
- b. How should the Baronage interact with the arts & science activities? The Barony has many thriving arts communities which support participants and expand friendships. We will likewise support these through the traditional and strong practices of special tournaments and court champions. We would also like to revive the practice of fostering largess for the Crown at Coronation events.
- c. What kind of role should the Baronage have in service activities? One of the most important jobs we can help with is fostering the engagement of the middle ranks of the Barony.

A strong tool we have in this job is working with all officers in the Barony and Her Cantons to educate the populace that these officers are necessary but don't have to be scary. As a group, we have many gentles who will mentor new officers with these responsibilities. We believe we need to promote these positions as good job experience in the modern world as well. This job also focuses energy on garnering volunteers for staff roles at events, and small project management tasks for the Barony.

We would seek to promote group projects within the Barony and Cantons. These activities can generate the feeling of community and friendship which is very important to making the SCA feel more like a family than an organization.

- d. How should the Baronage interact with the Baronial Officers? We respect that a strong relationship the Territorials and the Baronial Seneschal is keenly important for supporting each other; and for understanding our goals, resources, and responsibilities to each other. In addition to fostering that association, we will support the other Baronial officers in their responsibilities and goals.
- e. How should the Baronage interact with its satellite groups (Nordleigh, Blachemere, ARCC)? We intend to support the Barony's Cantons of Nordleigh and Blachemere by setting the goal of attending their business meeting at least quarterly. We feel this is very important in making sure that communication between the Barony and Cantons remain open. This will also facilitate understanding of any frustrations that could happen because of the physical separation of our groups. Each of the Cantons has a unique culture which the Baron and Baroness need to be aware of, and foster. Of course, this also includes the ARCC student group as it continues to grow.
- f. How should the Baronage interact with the Royal family of Northshield? We believe that the roles of Territorial Baron and Baroness serve as ambassadors to the Royalty, to the Kingdom, and to the Knowne World. We are humbled and strengthened by the understanding that many impressions of the Barony are formed when people meet the Territorials, and see their actions in Kingdom courts and on social media such as email & Facebook.

8. How long have you been in the SCA? **Geoffrey—Roughly 30 years; Samia—just under 20 years**
- Describe your past participation on a Local, Regional, Principality/Kingdom, and inter-Kingdom level. **Rich and varied (Please see our SCA resumes).**
 - Describe your experience with royalty, royal peers, and royal protocol. **Geoffrey has been head chamberlain for Aubrey and Anne, Hrodir II and Anne, Hrodir III and Anne II. Samia has assisted with the reigns of Tarrach and Fiona, Hrodir II and Anne, Hrodir III and Anne II. Geoffrey has stood jointly with Her Grace Anne as the Royal Archery champions for Siegfried and Therica during the Principality and as Archery champion for Wulfgar and Devon during Their reign. As a previous Baron for Nordskogen Geoffrey has experience in working with numerous Royal families.**
9. Will your modern life permit you to attend Baronial/Canton/College meetings and events on a regular basis? **Yes.**
- What sort of plans do you have in your modern life over the next few years? **We're both homeowners in the area, we're both married and pretty stable.**
 - Do you have the resources to support a multi-year reign? **Yes.**
 - Do you have a network of staff/volunteers to assist with your reign? What type of discussion(s) have you had with this group? **Yes, we have friends and household-family who are supporting us.**
10. Where do you see the Barony in 5 years?
- What sort of plans/projects do you intend to implement during your reign? **We wish to continue the good work of the current and previous Territorials. We also wish to better understand what brought new members to our organization so that we may replicate this process on a wider basis.**
 - What are your thoughts on recruiting and keeping new members? **It's a large part of the role of Baron and Baroness. We feel the recruitment and keeping of new members is one of the most important tasks that the Baronage can help with.**
 - What are your thoughts on the volunteer burnout rate in Nordskogen? **As stated above, we would like to cultivate the middle ranks of volunteers in the Barony. No one should have to keep a volunteer role they can no longer feel strong in.**
 - What value do traditions have to the group? What are your thoughts on bringing back old ones, and/or strengthening existing ones and/or creating new ones? **People enjoy traditions! Toys for Tots Tourneys, Baroness' Whim, Twelfth Night, even moots and potlucks. We should not be locked into activities that spend more energy than they revive in the group (for example, National Night Out). We should also be open to ideas that enthusiasm brings to the table—some of our best ideas for fun and camaraderie will come from our newest members (Connie's Cosmic Sandbox, potlucks at the Moots).**
11. How should Nordskogen interact with our neighboring Shires/Baronies? **We always need to be good neighbors. We should frequently remind smaller groups that we can put down financial deposits for their events if their cash-on-hand is tight. We should invite them to our activities, and attend theirs. When Samia was new, and lived in a neighboring shire, she clearly remembers the Nordskogen Baron and Baroness as "her" baronage. We need to be that for other newcomers, too.**
- How should Nordskogen interact with the Kingdom? (volunteers/finances/physical resources) **We believe the Barony should continue to serve when asked and/or when the desire calls to us. We are all members of multiple layers of the organization – from guilds and households, to Cantons, Barony, Kingdom, and Society. We each find different ways to give to this community, while maintaining balance with other parts of our lives.**
12. What personal associations (household(s), dependent relationships, etc.) do you have and what effect will they have on you being the Baronage? What effects will the Baronage have on them? **Samia is protégé to Geoffrey and Anne. Both Geoffrey and Samia are members in House Wortham, a service household with members from across Northshield. Currently, House Wortham members David and Claire serve as Territorial Baron and Baroness of Castel Rouge. Clearly, if Geoffrey and Samia are selected to serve as Territorial Baron and Baroness, this would have an impact on House Wortham, largely by changing the focus of activities again, as Hrodir and Anne's reigns have done. Samia is also friend-participation of House Cinquefoil, run by Dame Siobhan.**

It is important for everyone to understand that the relationship of Samia and Geoffrey should they become Baroness and Baron will be as Equals not as Dependent and Peer. Also we want people to know that our shared household will not be favored above any one person or group in the Barony. We will be Territorials for all of the people in the Barony equally.
