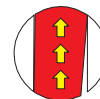

The Barony began the year with \$16,724.25 and ended the year with \$24,0003.82 for a positive balance change of \$7,279.57. This sum includes the \$2000 partial debt repayment from WW. It must also be noted that the GPS annual rent of \$4,035 and the \$1,200 for winter archery punch cards should be subtracted from this amount. So, the balance change will end up being more like \$2,044.57.

BOD Meeting, April 22, 2017: Baron Thomas Bordeaux

Numbers: 50 to 100. Hotel (Embassy Suites in Bloomington) has a room. Best attendance if reception held onsite. No outside food or drink. If we guarantee the food and beverage minimum, the room rent is \$1,500 (15 per a head). Otherwise, the room rents for \$9,500. Food order needs to be placed 2-3 weeks before the event. Partner with a shire (like Korsvag) in the western part of the kingdom. Approval to set it up with Korsvag and come up with more detailed bid in a month or two. Approval given. Will happen in the spring of 2018 so as to have time for planning and advertising. Suggestion: try not to conflict with Kingdom A&S.
