Marsden Archery Range is located in the northwestern part of Ramsey County in the city of Arden Hills (Lexington Avenue and Johns Road). The 8-acre site is bounded by Lexington Avenue on the east and the Twin Cities Army Ammunition Plant (TCAAP) on the south, west and north. The site is entirely fenced and contains 15 archery lanes with butts. Lengths of lanes vary from 10-40 yards. The site includes a 20-car parking lot and is just north of our old Wednesday meeting site at the armory.
