3. Each fighter will then have 3 betting chances to "up the ante"--buy a secondary weapon/device, subtract an opponent's secondary device, or trade in a card (see below). First "ante up" round costs a quarter, second 50 cents, third 75 cents.

4. Single fight, winning fighter gets a card from deck.

5. 2 Winners--best 5 card stud poker hand, and highest number of fights won.

Adjustments to tourney may be made on the fly depending on the number of fighters participating, speed of the action.
