Meeting was called to order.

I. <u>Crispin's Archery Thing</u> posted a \$23.80 profit in spite of a bad weather report.

II. <u>Anime Fusion</u> Help is still needed for our table, especially on Friday. Two comp tickets are still available for volunteers. Torimassa is loaning us some armor and three faceplates. Ivetta is bringing a non-period kimono and some Chinese books. Faelan has a Japanese outfit to lend if someone needs garb.

III. <u>Marscon 2015</u> will be held on Mar. 6-8, 2015, the first weekend in March. There is no conflict with Gulf Wars in 2015. Should we do a party room and/or try to do something in the smallish demo room? (They liked the dancing last year.) Let's think about which to do and please consider volunteering!

IV. The Armored Combat Event (THACO) 6 Bid

It would be held Saturday, April 28th, 2015, at the Oscar Johnson Ice Arena, 1039 Decourcy Circle, Saint Paul, MN, 55104, from 8 am-6 pm.
