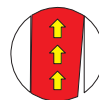

Meeting was called to order.

Announcements

Archery will be at Bwana this Sunday, April 19. There will be two events this weekend including THACO. Pick one. The Green Valley Greenhouse coupons are on Facebook and Baronial website. Hapsburgs at MIA throughout May. Go to it. Baroness needs award recommendations for WW. Kingdom A&S needs help with lunch clean-up and site clean-up (broom and dustpan) and Royalty Room guards (there or not, available for conversation or not) and gate and a couple of judges.

Event Updates, Recaps, and Bids

Baron Frederick de Fulbert on WW: Once the WW contract is modified and signed, social media will start to happen. He is not sure yet what positions need to be filled. More porta johns and garbage cans. Fee raised \$5. \$25-\$30; \$10-\$15; family cap to \$75; daytrip children: \$5-\$7; daytrip adults: \$10-\$15. \$5 more for RV people, too. The bar will stay open but now we know what to expect and will be bumping up security. There will be site tokens with different colors for the staff and others. There will be specially colored tokens for guests/seasonal folks. Attendees will be encouraged to wear their tokens. Doug is getting wi-fi. There will be a one-time fee (\$5) for your own password all weekend. There has been much clean-up of underbrush and pine needles. There is an acre more of parking. There will be some work weekends, too.
