**Seneschal, Lady Niamh ingen Dhomnail:** Policy updates are being reviewed by the officers, by May 1.

Knight's Marshal, THL Herjolf Eilifsson: Getting close to fighting outside, 1 injury report: an elbow that's fine.

#### **New & Replacement Officer Position Votes**

Thrown Weaponry. Lady Idonea le Lakere has targets and loaner gear, and wants to hold practice May 1, and every other week thereafter. Sunday from 10–12. If approved we will be assessing interest, to see what additional materials we will need.

Moved by Her Excellency Samia, Seconded by Lady Lewke. Majority approval, one against, one abstained. Will work with Azizah Hatun to collect the equipment.

Schützenfest (THL Caoilfhionn inghen Cheallaigh uí Mhórdha, Steward): 26 pre-registrations as of beginning of meeting. Schedule has been posted. Majesties coming to combat archery. Their Excellencies would like to cover the lodging and food cost for them (\$25 each). Moved by Azizah Hatun, seconded by Baroness Ekaterina Anastaseva. Barony approved, and will be taken up by finance committee. Equestrians are having a hard year and are saving money for 50 Year Celebration. Rivenwood Tower is donating funds toward the making of targets. They are wonderful. If the weather is awful, we will be in a hewn-wood dining hall. Port-a-potties have been ordered, 3 merchants signed on. Baroness Amalia St. Edmund and Mistress Gunnora Lovitt of Bucknell are doing the precooking. Volunteers are desperately needed!

Warriors and Warlords (Baron Frederick de Fulbert) - Website (warriorsandwarlords.org) is on new host and is up and live. April 30 – May 1 will be the first work weekend to do site cleanup from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., daily. Electricity is not available, so keep that in mind in bringing equipment.
