Geektastic A&S Competition at WW

As in previous years, I will be hosting an A&S Competition at Warriors and Warlords. I specifically encourage entries that are items of daily life, the sorts of necessary, but not necessarily super-shiny things that are important to medieval daily life. The Geektastic portion is that all entries are required to have documentation and the documentation is a significant component of the competition score.

This year, there are two changes from previous years - the competition judging will take place Friday evening (exact time and location TBD) and the judging will be public. This is something that we successfully trialed at Crown Tourney - entries are judged and the populace is invited to participate, whether that is sitting in and watching or asking questions about the process of the judging. Sort of a "performance judging," if you will. Entrants will have the opportunity to interact more with the populace about their entry and the Populace will have the opportunity to learn more about the A&S Competition process.

The Aquila Challenge

The Aquila Challenge will be a series of archery and thrown weapon contests sponsored by the Order of Aquila et Fulmen. Contests for both archery and thrown weapons will take place at Castle Fever, Northern Realms War and Warriors and Warlords. The results of all six contests (three archery and three thrown weapons) will be combined to determine an overall winner.

The Aquila Challenge will be a team competition. Teams may have up to four members. For each of the six competitions, only the highest score by a member of the team will count toward the overall Aquila Challenge score for that team.

The prizes for the overall winning team will be a quiver, one dozen arrows, three throwing axes and three throwing knives. Prizes will be awarded at Warriors and Warlords.

Enter at the **BACK** of the building. Door 1121C is the one closest to the rooms we are in.
