THE BARONESS' NOTES FROM PENNSIC 46

- Master Viði Hovdestad, Lord Helmut Strauss, and Baroness Kolfinna Hrafnkelsdottir represented the Barony with style and panache in the Baronial Champions Tournaments (Kolfinna served in the Rapier role, and C&T is not represented at Pennsic, and Herr Just von Stichem could not be at the war). Baroness Kolfinna in particular was called out by the Gallery of Barons and Baronesses, and other combatants, as a shining example of Baronial Championship.
- Half of the Kingdom Unbelt team, assembled by the King and Queen, were members of the Barony. They were honorable and joyful on the field of battle: THL Skio, Lord Helgi Moosebane, THL Taion Orbanus, THL Refkell Melrakki Einarsson, and Lord Helmut Strauss.
- Baroness Jehanette de Provins represented the Kingdom in the Arts and Sciences Open showcase with her hairnet display. Her hands-on practice tool was well loved by other netting geeks, and hopeful netting geeks.
- Goodman Levi was called out by King Konrad der Lowe von Ulm and Sir Herjolf Eilifsson for his impressive showing in the Rose Tourney, advancing the honor of Duchess Mary of Carrigart.
- Baroness Amalia St. Edmund, Dame Marwen de la Rivere, Lord Madoc ap Jones, Azizah Hatun bint Da'ud, and Master Viði all represented the Kingdom in the War Point Shoot. Azizah shot a 58 in the clout shoot, impressing the rest of the team.
- Master Viði represented the Kingdom as the fifth alternate in the Archery Champion's Shoot, which represented 3 of the 6 Archery War Points. This is a high honor for which several dozen people competed.
- King Konrad was named by the Rapier Champion of Andelcraig as the best memory she will take away from the war with his joyful battle cry during the woods battle.

Seneschal, Baron Thomas Bordeaux: A work party consisting of Baron Thomas, THL Bazyli, Lord Wolfstanus, and Baron Geoffrey went to Master Crispin Fletcher's and Lady Idonea le Lakere's to prepare for the moot. They trimmed several pine trees. Come and have fun at the moot, dressed as you like. Games that will definitely be there include: Hunker Hauser—type of tug of war widely believed to be period, a Jenga set made of 2x4's, and Tong Honk, period Norse tug of war. Dame Siobhan Medhbh O'Roarke is loaning her purple peril so there will be shade. Bring your crafts!

A signed rental agreement plus a 20% deposit of \$260 will be needed to confirm site rental plus a certificate of insurance covering up to \$2 million dollars. (This certificate does not need to be provided immediately.). Also, they'll need to know if the person leading our archery activities holds a safety certification from an organization such as USA Archery. The MIT for the event, Duchess Anne Geoffreys of Warwick, was already planning on getting such a certification this fall. Baron Geoffrey of Warwick will also be getting certified. The date proposed is the first weekend in May 2018. The equestrian community will be invited and told that there no facilities. We will reach out to THL Alissende de Montfaucon about equestrian activities. There will be Bardic activity at the event. We are planning on also having thrown weapons. Baroness Coquette du Lyons moved and Dame Siobhan Medhbh O'Roarke seconded to approve \$260 for deposit. Motion passes.
