WW T-SHIRT GUIDELINES

The theme is WW 25 (WW XXV). **Deadline for design is June 10**. No exceptions. Send your designs to bazyli1592@gmail.com. The design is up to you - you don't have include fish or snowflakes or griffins, but some version of those has been traditional.

Design should be no more than 13" in any dimension. 11" is ideal.

The shirt itself will be grey or another neutral color, depending on the design chosen and shirt availability.

T-shirt will be 4 colors, but don't blend colors. Colors should be solid and not mixed or blended, i.e., for screen-printing you can't layer red and yellow to make orange.

Black outlines are suggested. When submitting, you can send the black line drawing, and we can discuss colors. Or you can submit a design with 4 colors.

Please note:

Your art will have to be separated into 4 colors for the printer, which means we'll be submitting 4 separations, one for each color. Your art will be made into vector art or into a PDF.

If you are able to create art separations and/or vector art, please include a note to that effect when submitting.

If you can't, we can work with you and help if your design is selected.

Designs will be selected by WW stewards and staff. If WW staff wishes to submit, they certainly may, but will not be one of the jury members to avoid conflict of interest.

CAMPING SPACE RESERVATIONS

Camping at WW is available by reserving spaces or by arriving and choosing from remaining areas. There's a lot of room, so last-minute arrivals can be accommodated. Just let the Gate volunteers know that you need a space when you arrive and they will direct you to the open spaces.

Camping space can be reserved in advance in one of two ways: Sweat Equity and Paid Preregistration.

Sweat Equity is an unusual SCA reservation practice, but one that has been in play at our current event location. Much of the land was undeveloped when we first moved here, and many groups have worked to develop small areas into beautiful campsites. Those gentles who have invested their personal time and money into the beautification of their campsites have earned the right to reclaim and "freshen-up" that same spot during the work weekends each year. Each group needs to have a representative connect with the Autocrats before the end of May to indicate their intentions to use the same area as the previous year. In order to help expedite the Trolling-in process at Gate, a list of those adults expecting to camp in the group's area should be submitted via the Sweat Equity form. Only one paid preregistration from a member of the group is needed to hold the traditional space for the group. While still not refundable, the preregistration monies paid will be transferable to others within the group.

Paid Preregistration for WW is offered to those people who are unable to or uninterested in participating in the sweat equity process but still want to have camping land reserved for them. This is a good way for out-of-town groups and households who wish to camp together to make sure that they are not scattered throughout the campground when they arrive. Payment and reservation details (Name, estimated arrival date & time, and camping area preferences) must be received by **June 23rd** to guarantee that a spot will be held. No additional fees will be charged to have land reserved but know that preregistration payments are not refundable.

Here are the forms: Preregistration Form Sweat Equity Form
