ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Three important announcements have appeared from the Board of Directors this summer and are reprinted here to make sure that everyone has a chance to see them.

At the Board of Directors July 2018 meeting, the following changes to Corpora were approved and were to be considered effective immediately.

Corpora Article X, Grievances and Sanctions, A. General, Add Section 4: Hate Speech

Hate speech is not tolerated in the Society. Hate speech is speech or symbols that offend, threaten, or insult individuals or groups, based on race, color, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, disability or other traits. Such symbols and speech have no essential part of any discussion of ideas and are of so little value to the Society that any benefit that may be derived from them is clearly outweighed by the harm caused. The use by any participant in the Society may result in possible sanctions up to and including revocation of membership and denial of participation.

Please report any possible instances of hate speech to your Kingdom Seneschal, the Society Seneschal or the President of the SCA immediately. For more information about hate speech and the reporting of same, please refer to the Society Seneschal's Handbook.

GENDER NEUTRAL TITLES FOR HOLDERS OF AWARDS OF ARMS

The SCA now has approved gender neutral titles for the AoA level. This information below is quoted from the Laurel Sovereign of Arms' July 2018 letter which can be found here.

"From Pelican: Gender-neutral titles

The April LoPaD asked for commentary on three possible gender-neutral English titles at the Award of Arms level: Armiger, Gentle, and Noble.

Armiger literally means a person who bears arms. The word was used after names in our period, as in "Garl of Ducheman, Armiger". We approve its use as a title in the form "(Given Name), Armiger" or "(Name), Armiger."

We approve Noble as a title used before a given name, as in "Noble Sampsoun" or "Noble Edwarde".

The majority of commenters opposed restricting use of the word Gentle to Society members of a particular rank. Therefore, we are not protecting that word as a title at this time."

[Notes from the editor:

The Laurel Sovereign of Arms is the highest ranking herald in the SCA.

"LoPaD" stands for "Letter of Pends and Discussions". The LoPaD is defined as a letter written by the Sovereign(s) of Arms to identify submissions which have been pended and issues which require discussion by the College of Arms.

"Pelican" refers to the Pelican Sovereign of Arms. The Pelican Sovereign of Arms is one of the Laurel Sovereign of Arms' two principal deputies and is responsible for the review of all name submissions for individuals and groups in the SCA and for determining if they should be accepted or returned for further work.]
