GENERAL NEWS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

Canton Of Nordleigh August Craft Night – Let's Make A Cloak (Pattern)! –Thursday, August 8, 2019, 7-10 p.m.

Haven't you always wanted a cloak of your own, one that runs all the way to your ankles?

WHEN: On August 8 (7 to 10 p.m.) at our crafts night for pre-1600 crafts. Join the class offered or bring your own craft to work on.

WHERE: We meet in the hall at <u>St. Peter's Lutheran Church</u>, 418 East Sumner Street, Northfield, MN. Enter the hall from the back parking lot.

THE CLASS: We will make a pattern for a simple cloak with a hood that is just your size with NO SEWING, NO MATH, ONLY FOLDING AND CUTTING. Of course, later, you (or a friend?) will need to sew the cloak by using your pattern on your own choice of fabric. And yes, children with patience can make their own pattern too.

For a full-size pattern, bring two old sheets or make a true but smaller pattern using an old pillowcase or a man's handkerchief, or paper I will supply. (Hint: Secondhand shops have some inexpensive fabrics.)

SUPPLIES TO BRING: two old (plain with no pattern works best) bedsheets for fabric twice as tall as you and as wide as you; a dark pen or felt tip for marking it; and scissors for cutting it. Bring a measuring tape or a string (the string as tall as you plus 10 inches); a yardstick if you have one; 12 inches of ribbon (or yarn or string); a pack of straight pins (I prefer the ones with yellow heads) or safety pins; and a bag to carry home your pattern.
