Officers' Reports (con.)

Quartermaster, Baroness Kateryn of Roseberry Topping, called Khadijah: Our lock was cut and our unit was broken into sometime between July 15 and August 15. The only thing missing is our Keurig coffee maker. The unit was not messed up except for a weird box containing trash (opportunistically left behind not by the thieves but by folks leaving a storage unit?) and the broken lock. The old lock was put on to secure the unit. Will get the round lock that the storage place recommends. Who has a copy of the contract? Insurance? Police report? Barony has 13 heavy, wooden tables. Some of them are rickety. Last time of use: 1 or 2 in 2017 (borrowed by Giovanna). Khadijah suggests that we get rid of at least half. It was suggested that we sell half of the good ones through the jumble sale at Twelfth Night.

Old Business

Warriors and Warlord 2019

Event report currently being compiled. 745 attendees, 95 more than 2018. 632 adults, 113 minors. (much better outcome than the usual 20% drop in attendance due to moving to a new site.) Spent \$4107.02 less than 2018. Current profit: \$8,444.39. However, some expenditures still need to be made. \$632 equipment maintenance and autocrat discretionary. \$250 deposit for next year. WW plans on paying back the remaining \$2000 that was borrowed from each Barony and hopes to send a donation of \$1 per adult to Kingdom if both Baronies approve. There was an injury: Toyaoka Katsuo was bit by a horse. The dates have been reserved for 2020: July 5-12; event will be from July 9-12. We will not be sharing the site with others in 2020.

Twelfth Night 2020

Working on the budget. Need more staff. Lord of Life Church reserved for Jan. 11, 2020. Setup on Friday, Jan. 10 from 6-10 except gyms. We can bring in mats the night before to warm up and then spread them out in the morning. Site is open from 7am-10pm on Saturday. 10pm is a HARD close. Haven't decided whether feast will be pre- or post-court. Taking bids on feastocrat. Have MiCs for heavy and rapier. A volunteer is needed for the jumble sale. Will be talking to our boffer and archery people. Theme: Barony's 40th anniversary. Note: in modern usage, the 40th anniversary is the ruby anniversary. Ideas on this theme can be sent to the Twelfth Night autocrats.
