In December 1979, the Shire of Nordskogen became the Barony of Nordskogen. At Twelfth Night we therefore celebrate our fortieth anniversary as a barony with martial tournaments, an arts and sciences competition, a delicious lunch, dancing, shopping, and many other activities on Saturday, January 11, and an archery competition at Bwana Archery on Sunday, January 12. It will bring together many of the things that we love about our barony and the Society as we visit with old friends and meet new ones. We hope to see many of you there!

The new year is a time of resolutions and fresh starts, and the turn of a decade adds to the symbolic weight of change. All clichés aside, we have a serious plea for you: we need volunteers. TOYS FOR TOTS/SOCKS OF LOVE FINAL TALLY

The totals for the 2019 Toys for Tots and Holiday Socks of Love tournaments are in, and my heart is bursting! With two hours of challenging shoots and unexpected rule changes, the archery tournament on Sunday brought in 213 toys total (151 donated that day and 62 donated early for Socks of Love after the tourney was rescheduled). Combined with 282 toys donated during the rapier tournament and 50 during the youth boffer tournament, we have donated a whopping 545 toys to kids who might not otherwise get gifts this holiday season.

My friends, I'm overcome by your generosity and enthusiasm. Thank you to everyone who donated, entered a tourney, marshaled, organized, counted toys, and otherwise made this multipart tourney happen!

Note from the Editor: Last year's final total was 398, so this is about a 37% increase!

Their Excellencies Baroness Caoilfhionn and Baron Gabriel: Toys for Tots and Socks of Love was a stunning success. At the archery tourney, 213 toys total were donated (151 donated that day and 62 donated early for Socks of Love after the tourney was rescheduled). Combined with 282 toys donated during the rapier tournament and 50 donated at the boffer tourney, the Barony gathered a total of 545 toys. With the help of our contribution and those of many others, Socks of Love was able to fill 1200 stockings for MN foster children this year. We moved to our new storage unit in less than 4 hours and in one trip! Mats are out for 12th Night already. Ropes and flags for list missing from second theft. Replace ropes for heavy and rapier.
