KINGDOM OF NORTHSHIELD'S UPDATED CANCELLATION STATEMENT AS OF APRIL 5, 2020

Greetings to the people of Northshield,

This is a challenging time for all and we hope you are coming through it the best you can. It warms the hearts of myself and the Crown to see you supporting each other online in so many ways. Whether it's being active in teaching classes, making masks, or sharing fellowship. We are also glad that you are recognizing that not everyone is equipped for that and people are supporting that as well. Our diversity is our strength and we can all get there together if we take turns sharing the load.

It is hard in these times of uncertainty to make plans and it is even harder to have things taken from you again and again.

So rather than extend cancellations for two weeks at a time again and again, based on CDC guidelines for social distancing, the kingdom is canceling all in-person activities through the end of June. We realize that this may seem extreme. However, increasingly we are hearing that the peak will not hit many of our states until June, July and even into August.

WW27 Skipped Year Art Announcement from Theign Nikolaus der Ausländer

This is a general call out to the 2D artists in the Kingdom!

We're looking for art for the AS 55 (LV) The Year Without WW T-shirts. Here's the specifications:

Finished artwork should fit a square.

Vector art (encapsulated postscript) is preferred, but high-resolution JPEG or TIFF (3+ Megabyte--300 dpi or higher at 12 inch width), or even a clean scannable drawing on paper are acceptable. All art should be line art; no shading or blending (Think paint-by-number style.). Theign Nikolaus can scan physical art into appropriate formats; please send art to Clint Hotaling via PM or Theign Nikolaus's email. Please PM him for his snail mail for physical artwork.

All art should incorporate the following text: "A.S. LV – The Year Without Warriors and Warlords" in some way. An ampersand can be substituted for the word "and". We prefer "Warriors and Warlords" but if the design is exceptional and has "WW" instead, we'd consider it.

All art should incorporate at least one catfish (Jararvellir) and at least one snowflake (Nordskogen). Preferably equal numbers, but don't let that stop your creativity. Last year's totes had a snowflake made up of six catfish. T-shirts will be Primary Red (a dark saturated red), and the art can as many as four inks. Remember the heraldic rules of contrast! (Ask your local herald what those simple rules are.)

Deadline for submissions is May 15th. Submissions will be juried by the Event Steward Team. The artist of selected art will get their own T-shirt. All proceeds will benefit the Northshield General Fund.

If you use one item for multiple cards, an "x" must be placed in the upper right hand corner of the square, so Lady Jelena doesn't go looking for items that aren't there. If you are really good at making one thing, making five of those things qualifies as a Bingo.

Deadline and Prizes

The soft deadline is October 1st so that prizes can be distributed at Twelfth Night.

Prizes will be awarded for 5-Across, 5-Down, Diagonal, Four Corners, and Black Out.
