

<u>UPDATED RESOLUTION TO SUSPEND IN-PERSON SCA ACTIVITY—NOW THRU MAY 31, 2121</u>

Greetings:

At the end of July, the Board of Directors issued a proclamation suspending most in- person SCA activities in North America until January 31, 2021, due to the COVID-19 global pandemic. In November, we asked the Kingdom Seneschals and Crowns of the known world to give us their counsel on how to proceed in the first part of 2021. We received very thoughtful responses from nearly all Crowns and Kingdom Seneschals as well as many other concerned people. We wish to thank everyone who responded for taking the time to do so, and for putting such effort into your responses.

After reading and discussing the feedback received, the Board decided at their conference call meeting on 12/01/2020 to continue the suspension of in-personactivities in North America through May 31, 2021. That action reads as follows:

Motion by Ross Rougher to extend the *Resolution to Suspend In-Person SCA Activity until January 31*, 2021, originally issued by the Board of Directors on July 28, 2020, for a period of four (4) months, until May 31, 2021. Second by Gigi Coulson. Opposed: none. Absent: Jennifer Krochmal. Motion carried.

While there is good news on the horizon regarding effective vaccines and other ways to treat and manage COVID, implementation of those treatments is still in the future. The current situation shows that infection rates are continuing to increase in many places throughout North America. The most important concern at this time must be the safety of all participants.

Please remember that federal, state, provincial, and local health directives and guidelines must continue to be followed whenever Kingdoms decide to authorize smaller local in- person meetings and local fighter practices. These local activities remain under the discretion of the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal. Kingdom Earl Marshals are welcome to give advice to the Crowns and Kingdom Seneschals when approving local practices.

Virtual events, as have been happening in many kingdoms, are of course allowed, and encouraged to continue. If a Kingdom believes that the circumstances in their area allow for an in-person event, beyond approved local practices and meetings, to be held safely before May 31, 2021, the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal are welcome to discuss a variance with the Society Seneschal.

Such variances for events beyond local practices and meetings will be considered, but please keep in mind that limits on participants, mask requirements, local government approval, insurance questions, vaccine availability, and actual conditions regarding the epidemic in the Kingdom requesting the variance are all important issues that will be considered and discussed for any requested variances prior to the May 31, 2021 date.

Further, as stated in the original *Resolution*, if a Crown or Coronet feels the need to step down without heirs, a regent may be installed according to the laws of the kingdom or principality. If those laws are not adequate for the situation, the kingdom is invited to work with the Society Seneschal to create a solution that will be in the best interests of the kingdom or principality.

Live events and personal interactions are a large part of the way the Society has continued over the last fifty-plus years. These restrictions on live events in the SCA are painful, but the state of the world, and the well-being of everyone involved, currently require we be as careful as possible.

It does look like there will be vaccines available soon and once the epidemic is under some semblance of control, we can have live events again and celebrate all our interests and community safely.

RESOLUTION TO LIFT SUSPENSION OF IN-PERSON ACTIVITY IN THE SCA AS OF JUNE 1ST, 2021

From: The Board of Directors, and the offices of the Society Seneschal, and President

On March 23, 2021, the Board of Directors passed the following:

Resolution to Lift Suspension of In-Person Activity in the SCA as of June 1st, 2021

- I. Whereas the challenge created by the COVID-19 Global Pandemic demanded heightened safety standards which led to a suspension of in-person activity in North America by the SCA Board of Directors;
- II. Whereas the crisis of the Pandemic is being addressed through a combination of social policy, as well as scientific and medical advancements:
- III. Whereas the SCA Board of Directors continues to prioritize the health and well-being of the membership and participants of the SCA; and
- IV. Whereas the directed suspension of in-person events in North America expires after May 31st, 2021; now, therefore, be it
- V. *Resolved*, that the SCA Board of Directors lifts the suspension of in-person activity in North America, effective June 1, 2021, provided adherence to the items in this resolution;
- VI. *Resolved*, that all attendees in North America must follow all province, territory, state, and local health guidelines at SCA events. In addition, at all North American SCA events:
 - A. Masks that fully cover the mouth and nose must be worn by all attendees over the age of 4 at all times and during all activities except for eating and drinking;
 - B. Court, bardic circles, or any activity that involves voice projection shall also require that masks be worn at all times. Sound amplification devices are highly recommended;
 - C. No day board, water bearing, or food of any kind shall be provided by event staff or attendees to other attendees. All attendees must provide their own food and beverages;
 - D. While consuming food or beverages, attendees are required to remain stationary and follow social distancing rules;
 - E. No overnight camping shall be allowed;
 - F. All events shall be held outdoors;
 - G. There shall be a maximum of 150 people at any event; and,
 - H. All events shall require preregistration.
- VII. *Resolved*, that the SCA Board of Directors mandates applicable Kingdoms who have determined that it is safe to host in-person events before June 1st, 2021 or who propose any deviation from the above restrictions to request a variance from the Society Seneschal in order to hold the proposed event. The Society Seneschal shall have the authority to grant or deny these requests. These requests will be reviewed by the Board using the same review method used for variances to Corpora;
- VIII. *Resolved*, that small local gatherings including, but not limited to: guild meetings, officer meetings, and local martial activities including archery and thrown weapons shall remain at the discretion of the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal, in accordance with province, territory, state, and local health guidelines. Virtual events as alternatives continue to be a viable option;
- IX. Resolved, that enforcement of this resolution will be handled by the Society Seneschal and President of SCA Inc.; and,
- X. *Resolved*, that the SCA Board of Directors commends the hard-working officers, royalty, membership, and participants who have allowed the SCA to continue to flourish virtually as we lift this suspension and transition forward in a manner consistent with recommended health and safety standards.

The President and the Society Seneschal have been given the responsibility of implementing the resumption of events within the rules above and adjusting the strictures as needed with Board approval.

As per item (H) in the Resolution, SCA, Inc. has available the Event Module for the mandatory pre-registration process. All kingdoms are encouraged to utilize this tool. More information will be forthcoming from the SCA Accounting Specialist, Mazelle Attiya. If you would like to contact her about this available option, she can be reached at treasurer@sca.org.

THE CROWN OF NORTHSHIELD'S LETTER ON SCHEDULING THE NEXT CROWN TOURNEY

Greetings Northshield,

We know that everyone has been anxious to hear details about the Crown Tournament and the SCA reopening. Hopefully by now you have seen the official reopening notice from the BOD. If not please see: <u>BOD Resolution to Lift Suspension of In-</u>Person Activity in the SCA as of June 1st, 2021

We have received a variance from the BOD to hold our Crown Tournament as scheduled in June and to allow the Northshield Law that one member must have the ability to cross the border to be waived for this crown. Coronation is planned to be held, as normal, in September.

We feel it is important to get the kingdom back to a normal royal rotation as soon as possible, which is the reason we are not waiting longer to hold crown.

We hope that Our Heirs will have the task of bringing SCA back to in person activities. We foresee this will be challenging due to the pandemic not being completely eradicated and various people will be hesitant to attend events in person for a myriad of reasons. We may have to live in a hybrid SCA world for a while.

At this time, it is hard to say what our summer will look like. We plan to step down in September. We hope that much of Northshield will be able to attend the coronation of our Heirs. We would also like to give our Heirs the opportunity to plan a Coronation and have time to plan their reign. Hopefully, the pandemic will have improved by September and US States and Canada will have less restrictions. We would also like to be able to attend some events in person. We have not forgotten the people on vigil and will be contacting them about their peerage ceremony plans. We feel a slow reopening will give everyone time to readjust back to in person events.

Here are the current crown plans:

Crown will be held at Duchess Mary and Duke Lars's home. The Crown bid Duchess Mary submitted had an alternative option to host it at their home. Due to the event size limitations from the state of MN, holding the event at Lord of Light is cost prohibitive.

At this time, the border is closed and our combatant in Canada while thoroughly acceptable to the Crown will most likely be unable to attend. We hope that Canadian combatant can join us, but if they cannot we will be moving forward with the tournament. While the border being closed has never happened before it is not the first time combatants have not been able to compete due to forces outside of our control. Deciding this has been very difficult for us. Our Canadian groups are very important and they are integral to Northshield. We have no control over the border situation nor do have any insight to predict what the governments will do.

Attendance to Crown will be limited to Combatants, Consorts and one attendant per couple. The rest of the attendance spots will be reserved for essential officers and event staff. Pre-registration will be required.

We wish to have as safe and healthy an event as possible. We will abide by local and state pandemic regulations, as well as the SCA rules from the Resolution to Lift Suspension of In-Person Activity in the SCA as of June 1st, 2021

To all the people of Nordskogen, Nordleigh and Blachemere, greetings:

Happy SCA New Year! (May 1). Although in this new year of AS 56 we are still dealing with the pandemic, closures of a lot of the SCA, and not holding events, there is a light at the end of this tunnel! As you may have seen, the Kingdom is permitting limited group meetings and practices between now and June 1. After June 1, the SCA permits events to be held, although they will be of limited size and have certain other restrictions.

On June 19, Blachemere will host Northshield Crown Tournament. In-person attendance is closed due to state restrictions, but the tournament will be streamed live and recorded for all to see.

Practices are beginning again! When weather allows, thrown weapons, armored combat, and rapier are meeting. Again, these gatherings have limitations based on SCA and state guidelines. For armored combat in specific, if you need to use our loaner armor, you must tell the knight marshal, Baron Bazyli, no less than 24 hours in advance that you are planning on to attend. We want to remind people of one important thing: At this time, no matter what you're doing, if you're at an official SCA event, practice, meeting, or other gathering, you must wear a mask. Fighters and fencers, you need to wear a mask under your helm or fencing mask. This is mandatory.

Online activities continue as well! In addition to our usual Wednesday Nights Online, Caoilfhionn will host a fiber arts breakout room in the baronial Zoom on May 5 starting at 7:30. And, as always, keep an eye on the Northshield calendar for online courts and events.

Speaking of events, we are still planning our Wishes and Waiting event in July! We expect to host a variety of activities, some of which will be local small gatherings (such as a practice or social moot) and some online, including classes and an online court. If you have ideas for Wishes and Waiting activities, please contact the event steward, Baron Bazyli, and copy us. Baron Bazyli's email address is in this newsletter under Knight Marshal.

Might we also have some small, local events this summer? That is up to you! If you would like to dip a toe into running events, now is a great time. Please reach out to us if you have ideas!

As we plan for a slow opening of SCA activities, we need officers. At this month's business meeting we will have a vote of confidence for the office of Chatelaine, and we will meet candidates for Archery Captain. In June we will vote on the next Archery Captain and meet candidates for Herald. We will vote on candidates for Herald in July. If you are interested in any of these offices, please email the current officeholder and the two of us to let us know of your interest.

At the April business meeting, Seneschal Liadan announced that she must be away from the barony for an extended time due to work and is seeking someone to serve as interim baronial Seneschal through the month of August. If you are interested in this role, please email her and the two of us by the May business meeting.

One last thing: we know this has been a hard year, and we all are waiting anxiously to see how the SCA will return to something resembling normal. In this we ask that everyone have patience. There is a great deal in flux right now, and information changes often. Please keep an eye on the Barony and Kingdom webpages for updates to rules on gatherings, practices, and events, and keep state guidelines in mind as well. Everyone from the Board on down is working toward gathering again as we once did, but it is going to be a slow and careful trip—and that is a good thing.
