NORTHSHIELD EVENTS PROCEDURES as of APRIL 1, 2022

Below spells out the requirements for in-person events going forward from April 1st date:

All attendees in North America must follow all national, province, territory, state, and local health guidelines at SCA events. In addition, at all North American SCA events:

- a) Kingdoms may continue to require the use of masks at their events as they deem necessary;
- b) As research has shown that minimal transmission occurs from food, the serving of feasts, inns, day boards, and buffet-style food is now allowed at the Kingdom's discretion;
- c) Large coolers to dispense water into individual personal containers are now permitted;
- d) The following language is required to appear on all event notices, flyers, online announcements, and advertisements, as well as being posted in multiple locations (including gate) at any and all SCA-sponsored functions going forward:

Although the SCA complies with all applicable laws to ensure the health and safety of our event participants, we cannot eliminate the risk of exposure to infectious diseases during in-person events. By participating in the inperson events of the SCA, you acknowledge and accept the potential risks. You agree to take any additional steps to protect your own health and safety and those under your control as you believe to be necessary.

As has been stated all along, any and all state, provincial, or local health regulations and guidelines will of course need to be followed, including keeping up with changes to government policy based on updated information. Be aware that some local jurisdictions have stricter requirements than their state/province. We also strongly recommend following the safety guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Public Health Agency of Canada.

Additional Requirements for Northshield in-person activities (after April 1, 2022):

Masks are required for all activities for those who are not fully vaccinated (vaccination + 2 weeks) over the age of 5. Anyone who is fully vaccinated and still wishes to wear a mask is encouraged to do so. Masks are not required for indoor or outdoor activities for people who are fully vaccinated after April 1.

Thrown Weapons Activities

Greetings from the WW Thrown Weapons MIC! I want to invite any and all to join us on the TW range at WW - no experience necessary, loaner equipment and instruction will be available, social distancing is easy, *and* you get to play with live steel - no blunted tips or taped-on "edges" here!

There will be open range time every day as well as specialty and themed throwing events - the full event schedule will be posted soon! - but don't limit yourself to just one day! In keeping with the "three times lucky" theme of WW, there will be a progressive tourney on the TW field throughout the event. Participants from any skill level are encouraged and welcome to participate and prizes will be awarded for winners in novice, intermediate, and experienced skill levels.

The objective of the tourney will be to collect the highest scoring rummy hand by Saturday. On each day, participants will draw 5 random playing cards (multiple decks will be used - you may draw and keep identical cards). Their drawn cards will be placed on a hard target. They will have six throws (can be all knives, all axes, or three of each) and any card that they stick a weapon in they will keep. Participants will be responsible for keeping their earned cards from day to day. Throwers can complete ONE scored round each day (Thursday, Friday, and Saturday) with either knives or axes; the more days a thrower is able to participate, the more cards they will have the opportunity to add to their hand!

Participants will report their final hands and score by 3 p.m. on Saturday at the TW range. Throws for the Progressive Tourney can be made during any Open Throw time (there will generally be lanes available for open throwing most of the time, though there may be other activities and events happening simultaneously). Skill levels are determined on the honor of participants, but it is recommended that if you have won any skill-focused tourney that you consider yourself at least at the intermediate skill level and if you have been a group champion or participated in an invited tourney or team you should consider yourself at the expert skill level.
