To finish setting up pre-reg., we still need to get a Gate volunteer and decide when pre-reg. opens and closes. Dame Mary Elizabeth will give Baroness Rosanore copy on a request for volunteers. She will talk to Herald and group marshals. And, she will talk to Quartermaster and Baron Bazyli about the mats.

#### **New Business**

**Tournament of Chivalry Bid for Nov. 19, 2022 at Lord of Life Church:** Elvira Olite, event steward. Rental: \$950, insurance \$40, fighter food: \$50. Member fee: \$15, non-member: \$20. Staff: need gate, setup, cleanup, marshal in charge (Baron Bazyli will help recruit one). Setup: 8am, open: 9am, end: 4pm, leave: 5pm. THL Faelan & Dame Mary will help with heraldry. Certain to be a royal court. Baron Bazyli and Baroness have been advising her. Will be going to Financial Committee after the business meeting. Unanimous approval on vote for permission to shorten the timeline.

WW: Profit of \$2118.05. Half of that is Nordskogen's. Jararvellir has chosen to leave their half of the profit in the WW account. What would we like to do? There is \$19,422.00 in WW account currently. It cost \$17,435.95 to run WW in 2022. So, we basically have one WW's worth of money in the account. The Financial Committee meeting will be discussing this.

**Banner containing the Kingdom arms:** A banner containing a full achievement of the Kingdom arms has been rediscovered in the Kingdom regalia. The Barony created it (THL Neave inghean Domhnaill and Baron Bazyli made it.) and paid for it. It's not in the official Baronial inventory. Give it to the Kingdom? Yes, we will; present it in court at Twelfth Night. It's currently in Duchess Anne Geoffreys of Warwick & Baron Geoffrey of Warwick's possession.

**Warrant for Baronial Herald:** Baron Geoffrey is still on the Kingdom warrant list as the Baronial Herald. Baron Bazyli will check with the Kingdom webpage and with Lady Gwenlliana about the paperwork.

## NORTHSHIELD EVENTS PROCEDURES as of APRIL 1, 2022

Below spells out the requirements for in-person events going forward from April 1st date:

All attendees in North America must follow all national, province, territory, state, and local health guidelines at SCA events. In addition, at all North American SCA events:

- a) Kingdoms may continue to require the use of masks at their events as they deem necessary;
- b) As research has shown that minimal transmission occurs from food, the serving of feasts, inns, day boards, and buffetstyle food is now allowed at the Kingdom's discretion;
- c) Large coolers to dispense water into individual personal containers are now permitted;
- d) The following language is required to appear on all event notices, flyers, online announcements, and advertisements, as well as being posted in multiple locations (including gate) at any and all SCA-sponsored functions going forward:

Although the SCA complies with all applicable laws to ensure the health and safety of our event participants, we cannot eliminate the risk of exposure to infectious diseases during in-person events. By participating in the in-person events of the SCA, you acknowledge and accept the potential risks. You agree to take any additional steps to protect your own health and safety and those under your control as you believe to be necessary.

As has been stated all along, any and all state, provincial, or local health regulations and guidelines will of course need to be followed, including keeping up with changes to government policy based on updated information. Be aware that some local jurisdictions have stricter requirements than their state/province. We also strongly recommend following the safety guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Public Health Agency of Canada.

Additional Requirements for Northshield in-person activities (after April 1, 2022):

Masks are required for all activities for those who are not fully vaccinated (vaccination + 2 weeks) over the age of 5. Anyone who is fully vaccinated and still wishes to wear a mask is encouraged to do so. Masks are not required for indoor or outdoor activities for people who are fully vaccinated after April 1.
