The job has a yearly budget of \$100. We will vote on the position at the December business meeting.

Archery Captain, THL Faelan Bacach MacMillan: Survey coming up. Still getting folks showing up. A new person has been coming for two weeks. Also wants to sew and armor. Will wind down outdoors archery soonish. Going to the northside this Sunday, Oct. 23, 'cause it will be warm! Seeking a successor.

Old Business

TOC update

Still looking for a Gate person. Event is ending two hours later. Extra cost is being covered by a generous donor. Insurance application has been sent in. Baroness Caoilfhionn asks that Facebook event name been changed from "ToC" to "Tournament of Chivalry". Baron Bazyli is getting the mats there on Friday evening. Has arranged that the church will be available. Will coordinate with Kaydian. Note for the future: higher Lord of Life fees probably too expensive for a smaller event like this. At least one alternative has been found, fortunately.

Twelfth Night update

Lord Lachlann is Gate and THL Neave inghean Domhnaill is running pre-reg. and Paypal. Lady Helena is in charge of clean up. Baroness Rosanore doing website. THL Kagemori is the Heavy MiC. Insurance application has been sent in. Site payment has been rolled over from the year before. The price has increased and they are generously giving us the old price.

New Business

Storage unit

Rent is being raised from \$187 to \$243 for a 10 x 12 unit with no overhead light. \$125 paid by Baron Bazyli (\$131 without vet. discount) who for a 10 x 20 unit out in Buffalo. This company is not one of the big national ones that keep raising the price. Proposes we move in the spring. Quartermaster says yes to spring. And the new one out in Buffalo is just as close to her and probably in a better neighborhood. Okay with going to Buffalo alone when wouldn't be willing to go alone to the current one. Baroness Caoilfhionn asks will the budget be okay if we don't move until after taking inventory in the spring. HRH Guenievre du Dragon Vert: my 10 x 22 storage unit in Blaine is ok and costs just under \$200 a month, but it's outside. The company is Carefree Storage on Naples Ave. One price raise in a year. Duchess Anne Geoffreys of Warwick: Outdoors at her storage place, Freeway Mini Storage, in Columbus, MN, is \$125 for 10 x 20. It's right off of where 35W and 35E come together. No price raise in three years. Baron Bazyli is running this search. His report and plan will go to the Financial Committee in December. Baroness Caoilfhionn: Will change how we handle event planning. More of grabbing stuff the weekend before and keeping them for a week. Won't be able to grab stuff the night before and bring it back right after the event. Meistari Sefa Farmansdóttir: can we afford the higher rent for 7 months? Lord Lachlann: yes.

(Baroness Caoilfhionn) November in person Wednesday plan

Baroness Caoilfhionn's chart of results from the survey appear on the next three pages. Will look into getting the parlor at the fencing site once a month. Will also look into trying to get some moots together. As an action item, can put out a call with Lady Helena for teachers. Can do the same for moots. But general calls are not working! Need to actually contact each individual! Work your networks!

(Baroness Nell the Innocent, Nordskogen WW Event Steward) Discussion of increasing the gate fees for WW 2023 Formal budget will be presented to December financial committee meeting. Rental price of site is increasing. Proposed fee will increase to \$40 for members and \$45 for non-members. Daily fee will increase to \$25 a day.

(Baroness Nell the Innocent, Nordskogen WW Event Steward) Approval to move to a new storage unit for WW 2023

Current fee being raised from \$125 to \$153 and there is no longer a discount for paying for a year in advance. The new unit is still in Tomah, less expensive. New fee is \$90 per month, one month free when paying for a year in advance as we plan to do. Will be renting a smaller unit. Still discussing how to handle the insurance for the new unit. Baron Gabriel: Decision on this belongs to the WW financial committee, not us. We approve the budget. Meistari Sefa: Both Baronies make up the financial committee for WW. It's not a separate group.


Baron Bazyli moved and Lord Lachlann seconded a motion to adjourn.

Results of the Winter Meeting Survey


How likely are you to attend Wednesday-night Zooms for open social time (no activity or agenda) this winter?




If Nordskogen hosted an IN-PERSON, indoor meeting on one Wednesday night per month, assuming you were free, how likely would you be to attend?




How likely would you be to attend Wednesday-night classes on Zoom this winter? ²⁵ responses




Would you be more likely to participate in indoor social meetings if all attendees wore face coverings to prevent Covid transmission?


If Nordskogen hosted an in-person, OUTDOOR moot on a weekend day, assuming you were free, how likely would you be to attend?

25 responses




If Nordskogen hosted an in-person, INDOOR moot on a weekend day, assuming you were free, how likely would you be to attend?

NORTHSHIELD EVENTS PROCEDURES as of APRIL 1, 2022

Below spells out the requirements for in-person events going forward from April 1st date:

All attendees in North America must follow all national, province, territory, state, and local health guidelines at SCA events. In addition, at all North American SCA events:

- a) Kingdoms may continue to require the use of masks at their events as they deem necessary;
- b) As research has shown that minimal transmission occurs from food, the serving of feasts, inns, day boards, and buffetstyle food is now allowed at the Kingdom's discretion;
- c) Large coolers to dispense water into individual personal containers are now permitted;
- d) The following language is required to appear on all event notices, flyers, online announcements, and advertisements, as well as being posted in multiple locations (including gate) at any and all SCA-sponsored functions going forward:

Although the SCA complies with all applicable laws to ensure the health and safety of our event participants, we cannot eliminate the risk of exposure to infectious diseases during in-person events. By participating in the in-person events of the SCA, you acknowledge and accept the potential risks. You agree to take any additional steps to protect your own health and safety and those under your control as you believe to be necessary.

As has been stated all along, any and all state, provincial, or local health regulations and guidelines will of course need to be followed, including keeping up with changes to government policy based on updated information. Be aware that some local jurisdictions have stricter requirements than their state/province. We also strongly recommend following the safety guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Public Health Agency of Canada.

Additional Requirements for Northshield in-person activities (after April 1, 2022):

Masks are required for all activities for those who are not fully vaccinated (vaccination + 2 weeks) over the age of 5. Anyone who is fully vaccinated and still wishes to wear a mask is encouraged to do so. Masks are not required for indoor or outdoor activities for people who are fully vaccinated after April 1.
