Come to one or all, as a competitor or spectator, for a good time and a good cause at Nordskogen's Toys for Tots Tourney for armoured and rapier fighters!

Doors open at 6; tournament begins at 6:30; we need to be out by 9:30.

In this generous and occasionally silly challenge, entrants bring a donated toy in order to compete. (If you don't have a toy, don't let it keep you from participating! Noncombatants may donate toys on fighters' behalf, and we'll have extras!) Throughout the tourneys, spectators may make challenges or change the rules by donating additional toys.

As usual, we are emphasizing Toys for Tots donations for the youngest and oldest age brackets (babies and teens), as they are the most typically under-donated groups. Toys for Tots has some suggestions for teens: sporting equipment/bags/balls; books, backpacks, cosmetics, purses, watch/wallet gift sets, bath gift sets, board games, radio control cars/trucks, handheld electronics, skateboards/helmets, curling irons, hair straighteners, and hair dryers. Please avoid toys with religious themes, which require refills, subscriptions, or internet access, or that are limited to a single platform (e.g., for video games). When in doubt, pick something from one of the classic categories of toys. Sporting equipment, board games, dolls, cars and trains, books and art supplies are all good choices. You can't go wrong by donating a simple stuffed animal or a LEGO set. Please be aware that realistic-looking weapons and gifts with food will not be accepted by Toys for Tots.

Historical clothing is welcome but not required. Food is allowed in the hall so long as we clean up after ourselves: you may bring snacks or something to share. There are no restaurants within easy walking distance, but there are drive-thrus a short drive away.

Come to the side entrance of Olivet Congregational Church on Dewey St, through the garden. Parking is on the street; there are plenty of spots available in this quiet neighborhood.

Quartermaster, THL Muirenn ingen Fhairchellaig: Nothing to report since Baron Bazyli took care of the mats for ToC. Attempt to file officer change report has failed twice. Will contact Kingdom Exchequer directly.

Webminister and Social Media Officer, Baroness Coelwen ingen Adaim: Not present. From Facebook Messenger: All is well in the Social Media and Website side of things. Won't likely be in attendance for tonight. Miss all of your faces.

Old Business

Twelfth Night update

Major family stuff has come up and Dame Mary, the Event Steward, has gone home to the UK. Her Grace Petranella Fitzallen of Weston has volunteered to step in to finish the job. The Barony must approve this and did so tonight. Staff put together and will be put up on the website. Should hear about royal court and meetings tonight from Their Majesties. Want to have schedules and volunteer needs by Dec. 1. On her way to Austria from tomorrow through the 27th. Still reachable but not in the same time zone. \$5 addon to gate for lunch for 125. Should sell out. The Lunch Chef, THL Lucius Lartius Pavo, (Lor) will pay for it ahead of time and will be reimbursed later. Lord Lachlann is okay with this if receipts are gotten for everything.

Knight Marshal change over

THL O'no Kagemori has expressed interest in doing this. This month is the Q&A discussion. Has been a warranted marshal since about 2009. Served five years as Knight Marshal in Windhaven until he moved here. Two weapon and long sword his specialty. Also interested in melee fighting. Will continue the armoring Thursdays. Will work on engaging the new fighters. Vote next month. Baron Bazyli and Kagemori agree on sorting the loaner stuff and send a nice list (with pictures!) to the Quartermaster.

Mat replacement

\$200 per mat. Need to replace 3 or 4 of them. Proposal to charge a \$50 use fee even if the Barony uses them so that we accumulate replacement money over a reasonable period. Her Grace Petranella thinks the fee idea is brilliant! Put the fee in mat handout and event policies. Meistari Sefa: if it is put aside as a special fund, that would also need a change to the financial policy. Baron Gabriel: Can be set aside informally? Meistari Sefa: yes, but it would have to be tracked outside of the official reporting structure. Lord Lachlann: Will just send a query up the chain. Meistari Sefa: a special fund can't be rolled over from year to year unless it is put in the policies. Lord Lachlann: Might be best to say we replace x number of mats per year at x cost and put that in the budget. Baron Gabriel: that does track the income and outgo at least. Lord Lachlann, Meistari Sefa, and Her Grace Petranella will come up with a good way of doing this. Meistari Sefa: Barony should update financial policy annually. If changes are made, the Kingdom needs to approve. Financial committee will meet in December instead of November.

New Business

Toys for Tots

Gospatric de Reynes: Probably Sat., Dec. 10. Plan B: Fri., Dec. 9. Site: New fencing site. Probably for the usual \$20 an hour fee that we're charged. Would want the mats. (Note: fee for mats is not official yet.) Church secretary is trying to find out when the current Sat. rental needs to start. Patrick coordinator and Kage the MiC. Bazyli thinks a three-hour block is perfectly acceptable. Kagemori says four hours to cover setup and cleanup. Three mats probably needed. THL Faelan: Include rapier fighters too? Baron Bazyli says yes and will talk to Dona Rowan and Lady Helisius Morte d'Arbor for rapier MiC possibilities. Baron Bazyli: more challenging but doable on an evening. Note: Dec. 18 is Toys for Tots cutoff. Toy donation brings in more audience participation. Baron Bazyli suggests limiting list of rule changes to six. Let's figure this out this next week. Gospatric will talk to the church secretary again tomorrow.

NORTHSHIELD EVENTS PROCEDURES as of APRIL 1, 2022

Below spells out the requirements for in-person events going forward from April 1st date:

All attendees in North America must follow all national, province, territory, state, and local health guidelines at SCA events. In addition, at all North American SCA events:

- a) Kingdoms may continue to require the use of masks at their events as they deem necessary;
- b) As research has shown that minimal transmission occurs from food, the serving of feasts, inns, day boards, and buffetstyle food is now allowed at the Kingdom's discretion;
- c) Large coolers to dispense water into individual personal containers are now permitted;
- d) The following language is required to appear on all event notices, flyers, online announcements, and advertisements, as well as being posted in multiple locations (including gate) at any and all SCA-sponsored functions going forward:

Although the SCA complies with all applicable laws to ensure the health and safety of our event participants, we cannot eliminate the risk of exposure to infectious diseases during in-person events. By participating in the in-person events of the SCA, you acknowledge and accept the potential risks. You agree to take any additional steps to protect your own health and safety and those under your control as you believe to be necessary.

As has been stated all along, any and all state, provincial, or local health regulations and guidelines will of course need to be followed, including keeping up with changes to government policy based on updated information. Be aware that some local jurisdictions have stricter requirements than their state/province. We also strongly recommend following the safety guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Public Health Agency of Canada.

Additional Requirements for Northshield in-person activities (after April 1, 2022):

Masks are required for all activities for those who are not fully vaccinated (vaccination + 2 weeks) over the age of 5. Anyone who is fully vaccinated and still wishes to wear a mask is encouraged to do so. Masks are not required for indoor or outdoor activities for people who are fully vaccinated after April 1.
