February has flown by, and we are that much closer to fairer weather--hurrah! We are looking forward to our March inperson Wednesday gathering, at which Gospatric will be teaching wire weaving. See the Nib or the Facebook event for details.

We also had a great day at Lupercalia, with fencing and visiting, and of course an endless board of delicious food. Skol to the Shire of Rivenwood Tower for another excellent event!

We have lots of baronial business to highlight this month:

- The due date for largesse for Jararvellir's 50ish anniversary is March 15. Please make arrangements to get it to Her Excellency on or before that date.
- Bids for Twelfth Night 2024, kicking off the barony's 50th anniversary year, are requested by the March business meeting (3/15). If you have an idea but are not sure how to bid, please ask us or the seneschal. It's not too late!
- We are seeking a new Archery Captain, as THL Faelan will be stepping down this month. The archery captain organizes and promotes weekly practices, ensures safe shooting by marshaling or ensuring that a marshal is in attendance at practice, manages the loaner gear, and files reports with the kingdom. While it is helpful to be an archery marshal, it is not required for this position; strong communication skills and availability to attend practice regularly are key.
- We are also seeking a new Minister of Arts & Sciences. This officer fosters A&S activities in the barony in a variety of ways, from connecting students and teachers to organizing classes and displays/challenges/competitions and more. The MoAS files quarterly reports about local A&S activities with the baronial seneschal and the kingdom MoAS; these reports support kingdom-level arts recognition and networking, as well as the SCA's nonprofit goals.
- The position of Social Media Officer has gone unfilled for over a year. Can you maintain our Facebook page and group, share information to keep the barony engaged, and report regularly to the Webminister and kingdom?
- We are also seeking a Deputy Exchequer/Treasurer to learn how the barony's finances operate. Can you expand our corps of people who face spreadsheets with no fear?
- In addition, we are seeking a Boffer Captain. Would you like to teach beginning armored combat to children using padded (boffer) weapons? (Position requires a background check and authorizations.)

Finally, the process for finding our successors has begun! Applications for the Nordskogen Baronage open March 15 and close on May 1. To be considered for the role of baron/ess, please email an SCA resume and a cover letter describing why you wish to serve in this role to Their Highnesses Lars and Mary, Their Excellencies Caoilfhionn and Gabriel, and the Transitions and New Groups deputy, Wu Yun. <u>Wire Weaving Class Presented by Gospatric de Reynes At In-Person Social Practice, Wed., 3/8/23, 7:30pm</u> Sometimes called Viking wire weaving, Viking knit or chains in the Trichinopoly technique, this form of jewelry has been found in 10th century BCE Egypt, 2nd Century AD Rome, 6th century AD Byzantine, 10th century AD Scotland and 10th Century AD Indonesia. So many personas could have worn this type of jewelry. In this class we will learn to weave 24-gauge wire around a rod. Demonstrations of pulling woven wire through a draw plate will take place but if you are making something larger than a bracelet you probably won't be ready to use the draw plate on your weave within the time frame of the class. Pulling the weave through the draw plate transforms the weave into a durable flexible chain. Ten students will be able to take a spool of 24-gauge wire, a dowel rod, and a hard wood draw plate home with them.

KINGDOM OF NORTHSHIELD EVENTS PROCEDURES as of APRIL 1, 2022

Below spells out the requirements for in-person events going forward from April 1st date:

All attendees in North America must follow all national, province, territory, state, and local health guidelines at SCA events. In addition, at all North American SCA events:

- a) Kingdoms may continue to require the use of masks at their events as they deem necessary;
- b) As research has shown that minimal transmission occurs from food, the serving of feasts, inns, day boards, and buffetstyle food is now allowed at the Kingdom's discretion;
- c) Large coolers to dispense water into individual personal containers are now permitted;
- d) The following language is required to appear on all event notices, flyers, online announcements, and advertisements, as well as being posted in multiple locations (including gate) at any and all SCA-sponsored functions going forward:

Although the SCA complies with all applicable laws to ensure the health and safety of our event participants, we cannot eliminate the risk of exposure to infectious diseases during in-person events. By participating in the in-person events of the SCA, you acknowledge and accept the potential risks. You agree to take any additional steps to protect your own health and safety and those under your control as you believe to be necessary.

As has been stated all along, any and all state, provincial, or local health regulations and guidelines will of course need to be followed, including keeping up with changes to government policy based on updated information. Be aware that some local jurisdictions have stricter requirements than their state/province. We also strongly recommend following the safety guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Public Health Agency of Canada.

Additional Requirements for Northshield in-person activities (after April 1, 2022):

Masks are required for all activities for those who are not fully vaccinated (vaccination + 2 weeks) over the age of 5. Anyone who is fully vaccinated and still wishes to wear a mask is encouraged to do so. Masks are not required for indoor or outdoor activities for people who are fully vaccinated after April 1.
