LETTER ON THE BARONIAL TRANSITION FROM THEIR EXCELLENCIES

To all to whom these letters shall come do Caoilfhionn and Gabriel, Baroness and Baron of Nordskogen, send greetings.

It has been just over four years since the Baronial coronets were set on our heads and we first sat the Baronial seats. That time has been filled with fun, smiles, and sorrows. We have been baked by the sun at Warriors and Warlords, frozen in the cold of Twelfth Nights, and figured out how to do SCA at a distance during the great pandemic that spread through the Kingdom.

Now it is time for us to consider our retirement from these roles. We intend to step down in court at next Twelfth Night, in January 2024. Thus, we seek successors to take on this role.

Any individual or pair of people can apply to fill this role. You do not need to have decades of experience in the SCA or any particular awards or honors you have. Pairs do not need to be a romantic couple or of different genders. All that matters is that you have a love for the Barony, enthusiasm and energy to share, and a willingness to serve. If you have questions about what it takes to fill this role, please contact either or both of Their Excellencies. We also recommend talking with past Barons and Baronesses of Nordskogen, many of whom are still resident here or reachable online, and even with former territorial leaders from other baronies. We each have recommendations, observations, and information to share, and you will find great variety in the answers because each person brings something different to the role.

Their current Highnesses Lars and Mary will be our primary royal contacts for this process, so remember that their email address changes on April 1.

Applications will close on May 1. Further information will follow on scheduling of the candidates' meet-and-greet and polling of Nordskogen's populace, which is open to all who call Nordskogen home regardless of membership status.

It has been our joy and honor to serve in this role, and we look forward to celebrating our Barony and Kingdom through the remainder of our term before we pass the coronets--and all that they represent--to our successors.

BARONY OF NORDSKOGEN

Territorial Baronage Transition Policies

These are the official policies regarding the transition of the Territorial Baronage of Nordskogen, determined by the populace.

I. GROUP STATUS

It is the will of the people of Nordskogen to remain organized as a Barony within the Society for Creative Anachronism.

II. TERM OF OFFICE

The maximum term of the office of the territorial Baronage will be five (5) years. At the end of that time, there will be another poll to determine the baronage.

III. TERM LIMITS

There will be no limitation on the number of terms that a member of the territorial Baronage can serve. At the end of any term, the sitting Baronage may run again.

IV. JOB DESCRIPTION

The duties and responsibilities of the territorial Baronage will remain as set by Corpora and Kingdom Law, with one additional amendment: The baronage is expected to make a reasonable attempt to visit the Barony's canton as often as possible.

V. CANDIDATE CRITERIA

Polling will be by ticket. A ticket can consist of one or two people. The populace will be recommending to the Crown who they prefer for the territorial Baronage.

VI. POLLING CRITERIA

Any person in the Barony of Nordskogen, whether an SCA member or a non-member, may be included in polling for territorial Baronage.

- A. If more than four tickets are received, an initial internal vote of the populace will be conducted by the Seneschal to narrow down the numbers. If four or less tickets are received, a single poll will be conducted by the TANG office (Transition and New Groups).
- B. Members will receive their polls through membership information received from the SCA corporate office.
- C. Polls will be made available electronically or with paper as necessary for both members and non-members at announced baronial gatherings.
- D. It is the responsibility of those persons to complete and return the poll, at their own expense.

VII. STYLE OF THE POLL

The poll will contain the names of all the candidates, organized as tickets, from which the populace will then select their choices, and rank them as first, second, etc.

VIII. PUBLICATION OF CANDIDATES

The list of candidates will be published on a continuing basis, as nominations are accepted. This listing will be made available on the Barony of Nordskogen's website, on official Baronial Social Media and also in the *Crystal Quill*.

IX. CANDIDATE MEETING

There will be at least one candidate meeting for the populace to meet and talk with the potential candidates. The format for this meeting will be determined by an ad-hoc committee, and will be duly announced in advance of the event.

KINGDOM OF NORTSHIELD EVENTS PROCEDURES as of APRIL 1, 2022

Below spells out the requirements for in-person events going forward from April 1st date:

All attendees in North America must follow all national, province, territory, state, and local health guidelines at SCA events. In addition, at all North American SCA events:

- a) Kingdoms may continue to require the use of masks at their events as they deem necessary;
- b) As research has shown that minimal transmission occurs from food, the serving of feasts, inns, day boards, and buffet-style food is now allowed at the Kingdom's discretion;
- c) Large coolers to dispense water into individual personal containers are now permitted;
- d) The following language is required to appear on all event notices, flyers, online announcements, and advertisements, as well as being posted in multiple locations (including gate) at any and all SCA-sponsored functions going forward:

Although the SCA complies with all applicable laws to ensure the health and safety of our event participants, we cannot eliminate the risk of exposure to infectious diseases during in-person events. By participating in the in-person events of the SCA, you acknowledge and accept the potential risks. You agree to take any additional steps to protect your own health and safety and those under your control as you believe to be necessary.

As has been stated all along, any and all state, provincial, or local health regulations and guidelines will of course need to be followed, including keeping up with changes to government policy based on updated information. Be aware that some local jurisdictions have stricter requirements than their state/province. We also strongly recommend following the safety guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Public Health Agency of Canada.

Additional Requirements for Northshield in-person activities (after April 1, 2022):

Masks are required for all activities for those who are not fully vaccinated (vaccination + 2 weeks) over the age of 5. Anyone who is fully vaccinated and still wishes to wear a mask is encouraged to do so. Masks are not required for indoor or outdoor activities for people who are fully vaccinated after April 1.
