#### BARONY OF NORDSKOGEN

#### Baronial Territorial Baronage Transition Policies

These are the official policies regarding the transition of the <u>Baron and BaronessTerritorial Baronage</u> of Nordskogen, determined by the populace.

#### LGROUP STATUS

#### II. IERM OF OFFICE

The maximum term of the office of the baronageterritorial Baronage will be five (5) years. At the end of that time, there will be another poll to determine the baronage.

### III. HH. TERM LIMITS

There will be no limitation on the number of terms that a <u>Baron and / or Baronessmember of the territorial Baronage</u> can serve. At the end of any term, the sitting <u>baronageBaronage</u> may run again.

### IV. IV. JOB DESCRIPTION

The duties and responsibilities of the baronage territorial Baronage will remain as set by Corpora and Kingdom law\_Law, with one additional amendment: The baronage is expected to make a reasonable \_attempt to visit all of the Barony's subsidiaries (i.e., cantons, colleges)canton as often as possible.

### V. CANDIDATE CRITERIA

V. Polling will be by ticket. A ticket can consist of one or two people. The populace will be recommending to the Crown who they prefer for the territorial Baronage.

### VI. POLLING CRITERIA

Any person in the Barony of Nordskogen, whether an SCA member or a non-member, may be included in this pollpolling for territorial Baronage.

A. If more than four tickets are received, an initial internal pollyote of the populace will be conducted by the Seneschal to narrow down the numbers. If four or less tickets are received, a single poll will be conducted by the TANG office (Transition and New Groups).

- B. \_\_\_\_B. Members will receive their polls through membership information received from the SCA corporate office.
  - C. C. Polls will be ma demade available electronically or with paper as necessary for both members and non-members at announced baronial meetings. gatherings.
- D. It is the responsibility of the non-memberthose persons to complete and return the poll, at their own expense.

V. VI. CANDIDATE CRITERIA

Polling will be by "ticket", i.e.., the populace will be choosing the office of the baronage, whether that be one candidate running alone, or two candidates running as a pair.

#### VII. VII.STYLE OF THE POLL

The poll will contain the names of all the candidates, organized as tickets, from which tickets the populace will then select their choices, and rank them as first, second, etc.

### VIII. VIII. PUBLICATION OF CANDIDATES

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The list of candidates will be published on a continuing basis, as nominations are accepted. This listing will be mademade available on the most widely accessible source, the Barony of Nordskogen's website, on official Baronial Social Media and also in the <u>Crystal</u> Quill.

IX. IX. CANDIDATE NIGHT MEETING.

There will be at least one "Candidate Night" candidate meeting for the populace to meet and talk with the potential candidates. The format for this evening meeting will be determined by an ad-hoc committee, and will be duly announced in advance of the event.

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#### **BARONY OF NORDSKOGEN**

#### Barony of Nordskogen

General Policies and Procedures

These are the official policies of the Barony of Nordskogen, approved and effective June 19, 2013. (Date to be added once all is approved). In the

event of a conflict between these policies and any policies, regulations or laws of the Kingdom of Northshield, the Corporation, the State of Minnesota, or the United States; the policies, regulations and laws of the other

entity shall take precedence. The override of any single policy shall only negate that policy; all others shall stand. These policies do not apply to Nordskogen's Cantons and Colleges Canton, as those bodies it may maintain their ts own bylaws and policies.

#### GENERAL POLICIES

A. These policies should be reviewed annually in the month of February and published in the *Crystal Quill*. These policies may be subject to change at a later date approved by voted approval of as simple majority vote of the populace of Nordskogen present at the next general business meetingsmeeting.

B. L. Any policy amendment outside of the February review shall be proposed in writing at any general business meeting. This proposal will then be published in the *Crystal Quill* and will be voted on by the populace of Nordskogen present at the next general business meeting.

This final policy must also be published on the Baronial website.

#### CENERAL POLICIES

A.—It is the decision of the people of Nordskogen that there be no requirements for "citizenship" in the Barony. On matters put up for a vote or poll, the general populace of Nordskogen can participate.

D. \_\_\_\_The populace need not be paid members of the SCA, unless the question being voted on has a membership requirement instituted by Corpora or Kingdom, i.e., recommendation of Baron and Baroness Baronage.

B. The Baron and Baroness, or their designated proxy, have "day of" authority/ discretion to allow people to use the Baronial Pavilion at events where it's already set up and not otherwise committed (i.e.

meetings, meals for royalty, etc.). Independent uses of the pavilion (demos, other groups) must be approved by the Barony's populace at a general business meeting, so these uses must be requested in advance.

C. Any policy amendment desired shall be proposed in a general business meeting. This proposal will then be published in the Crystal Quill, and will be voted on by the populace of Nordskogen present at the next general business meeting.

D. These Policies, the Officer Policies, and the Financial Policies shall be published in the Crystal Quill

annually, at a time to be decided by the Seneschal and the Chronicler. Any changes to either set of policies shall be published in the Crystal Quill as soon as the change is made.

#### II. POLICIES REGARDING EVENTS

These are the policies for proposals and management for events in Nordskogen. It is the Barony's

responsibility and option to deviate from these policies in the best interests of the SCA or the Barony. The intent of these policies is to make proposing and running events easier and more equitable.

It is strongly encouraged that all first-time event stewards be mentored by an experienced event

steward. It is also encouraged that would-be event stewards shadow experienced event stewards, in preparation for becoming an event steward-for an event. It is expected that event stewards will have read and understand the financial policies of the barony.

E. A. Baronial Events:

 1. 1. Proposals for Kingdom Events (Coronations & Crown Tournaments), as well as for Warriors & Warlords, (WW) are specifically exempted from this section of policy.

Event Proposals 2. Proposal Steps

2. a. Initial

Event Proposals should include the event date, featured activities/-themes, event sites under consideration, and if possible, a rough estimate of the cost and / or breakeven numbers. This proposal should also note any other Kingdom events currently listed on the Kingdom

Calendar for the proposed date. The Barony will be looking at basic event viability and timing. If the populace approves the idea, the event date should be submitted to the Kingdom

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Calendar, and the event stewards may continue forward with site selection and budgeting. (Note—it is far easier to up d ate a Kingdom Calendar entry than to negotiate event dates on the calendar with less notice.)

1. b. Detailed Event Proposals must include the final site selection and costs, event budget and break-even numbers, and volunteers for all major event staff positions and should be presented at least three months before the event date. If the populace approves, the bid is given to the financial committee. See Nordskogen Financial Policy for more information.

3. Event Proposal Timing

a. Initial Event Proposals will be considered at any business meeting. It is upRequests to be added to the Seneschal's discretion whether to accept bids outside policy dates. The agenda should be sent to the Seneschal should be informed of any Initial Event Proposals being developed, in orderat least one week prior to help avoid d ate conflicts.

b. Detailed Event Proposals will be considered at anythe business meeting. Notification of the The agenda item should be sent out to the Barony via the e list at least one week prior to the business meeting, with prior notice to the Seneschal.

c. An event steward can bring forward a Detailed Event Proposal without first having received approval on an Initial Event Proposal (if all of the information is immediately available). The

Seneschal, after soliciting advice from the financial committee and trusted advisors, shall have discretion as to whether to entertain event proposals with less than six months of planning time.

d. If an Event Steward gains Initial Approval, but decides not to pursue the event further, this should be communicated to the Seneschal as soon as possible. The Seneschal will then cancel the event on the appropriate calendars.

### F. B. Moots

- 1. 1. Moots are understood as smaller or more focused events, with limited staffing needs and budget requirements, which may or may and are not be placed on the Kingdom calendar.
- 2. 2. Proposals for moots will be considered at any business meeting. Proposal Proposals should include date, theme-/activities, support needed, and any budget required.
- 3. 3. Proposals for moots must be approved at least two months prior to the moot date.

#### G. C. Warriors & Warlords

1. 1. As Warriors and Warlords (WW) is a joint event with the Barony of Jararvellir, and because the dates for the event are set far in advance, planning and approvals will be handled differently than all other events.

2. WW Event Co-Steward: Nordskogen will provide an event co-steward. The standard term of \_office is two years. A year as Deputy Steward in advance is highly recommended. Approval of the Nordskogen WW Event Co-Steward will be made by the Nordskogen Seneschal, in

- consultation with the Baronage of Nordskogen and the Jararvellir Baronage, Seneschal, and WW Event Co-Steward. If there are no applicants, the Seneschal will open the position for applicants using the Officer Policies.
- 3. 3. WW Staff Positions are appointed jointly by the Event Co-Stewards, in consultation with the two Baronial Seneschals. It is recommended that open positions be publicized.
- 4. 4. The Nordskogen WW Event Co-Steward will report progress to the Barony on the normal reporting schedule.
- 5. 5-Both the Nordskogen and Jararvellir must approve the WW Budget, per each group's financial policies.
- 6. 6. Major changes to the WW structure (dates, site, budget, major activities) require approval from both baronies.
- H. D. Kingdom Level Events Including Coronation & Crown Tournament
  - 1. 4. The Baronial Seneschal should be informed of any intended proposals for Kingdom Events, and be included in communications with the Kingdom Seneschal.
  - 2. Proposals must follow the guidelines set by the Kingdom, rather than Baronial policies.
  - 3. 3. The Event Steward must present the proposal to the Barony prior to final submission to the Kingdom, as the Barony is the official sponsoring entity. If the Barony does not approve the proposal, it may not be submitted to the Kingdom.

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- 4. 4. Kingdom Event Proposals will be considered at any business meeting. Notification of this agenda item should be sent to the Barony via the e listBaronial Seneschal at least one week prior to the business meeting, with prior notice to the Seneschal.
- 5. First time event stewards may not submit a proposal for a Kingdom Event without an experienced event steward as an active mentor.
- 6. Society level events should be treated similarly to Kingdom-level events. See Northshield Law and Society
  policies for further information.

#### H. E. Event Management

- 1. Votes for Baronial events and Kingdom events will be held by secret ballot. Votes for Mootevents, moots or changes to Warriors and Warlords are not required to be held by secret ballot.
- 2. Neither Nordskogen's Seneschal nor Exchequer may be an event steward for an official event
  - 8. during their tenure. This policy does not restrict these officers from running moots. This policy also does not affect other local officers or anyone holding a regional or kingdom office.
  - 9. 3. Progress Reporting In the interest of coordinating the efforts of the various officers concerned, and of responsibly managing the Barony's financial and other resources, progress reports are expected to be conveyed to general business meetings as follows:
    - 1. a. Pre-event: The event steward, in person or by deputy (who is expected to be well-informed), shall report at the general business meetings 6 months, 3 months, 2 months and 1 month prior to the event. The reports shall include a budget, attendance estimate, approximate feeany changes to the approved bid and updates on activities etc. and any other pertinent information.

schedule(s), site evaluation(s), schedule for the event (site open/close times, contests, tourneys, meals, courts, etc.), anticipated / possible problems, and any other pertinent information.

b.-Post-event: The event steward working with the Baronial exchequer will present a written report of his/her ownpersonal views on the event and two general business meetings after the event. This report shall include a financial report, attendance figures, problems encountered and suggestions for other event stewards (this last being the main reason for the postmortem). After the event steward report is given, any

- 2. questions, comments, or suggestions from the populace present at the post-mortem may be given. These items shall be noted and kept in mind for future events. The Seneschal shall file the post-mortem findings in order to increase the shared knowledge.
- 4. The Baron and Baroness do not have to pay site and feast fee for an event financially sponsored by Nordskogen. This privilege will also include Northshield royalty, visiting an event financially
- sponsored by Nordskogen, specific ally and limited to the King and Queen plus two retainers, and the Prince and Princess plus two retainers. Further exceptions regarding site and feast fees are at the discretion of the event steward.
- 5. Event receipts are due to the Exchequer no more than 30 days after an event. Exceptions only at the discretion of the Exchequer, as defined in the Financial Policies. See the Nordskogen Financial Policies for more information.
- 6. The event steward will keep items lost and found at their event, and provide a list to the
  - 10. appropriate populace. If unclaimed for 60 days after being published, the items will be considered donations to the Barony. The event steward, Seneschal, and Quartermaster shall decide disposition of the items.

### II. HI-POLICIES REGARDING BARONIAL EQUIPMENT PROPERTY, USE AND STORAGE

- 1. A. The territorial Baronage, or their designated proxy, have day-of authority to allow people to use the baronial pavilion at events where it's already set up and not otherwise committed (i.e. meetings, meals for royalty, etc.). Requests for use of the pavilion outside of Baronial events and moots must be made in writing to the baronial seneschal. Then must be approved by the Barony's populace at a general business meeting. This approval must be ratified by the Baronial Financial committee.
- 2. Property Management
  - 1. 1. The Quartermaster will supervise the planning, loaning, storage, and maintenance of Baronial property.

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- 2. 2. The Quartermaster shall maintain an inventory of all Baronial property, including such
   equipmentproperty as is held by guilds or officers, others or property not stored in the shedbaronial
   storage.
- 3. 3. All Baronial officers with Baronial property in their care will provide an accurate inventory to the Quartermaster on an annual basis. This inventory is due to the Chancellor of the Exchequer by the end of December, one monthNovember, two months before the Domesday Consolidated Year-End Report is due. The Quartermaster shall collect inventories of items held by officers and the populace and include it in their report.

#### collect inventories of items held be officers and the populace and include it in their report.

4. 4. The Quartermaster, the Seneschal, and the Chancellor of the Exchequer shall each hold keys to the shed baronial storage. They may also agree on approve additional deputies to hold keys as key holders. These deputies must be members. One of these individuals must be present when property is taken from or returned to the shed baronial storage.

#### 3. B. Policies

#### 1. 1. Planning

- a. The Quartermaster or Minister of Regalia must be included in any discussions or decisions
  regarding the purchase or creation of any new Baronial property, in order to ensure that storage
  and maintenance is being planned for. All decisions must be ratified by the Financial
  Committee.
- 2. 2. Loaning property to groups outside of Nordskogen.
  - 1. a. Nordskogen and its eantons/collegescanton have precedence for the use of Baronial equipment. property.
  - To make a request and arrange a pick up timecontact the baronial Exchequer. The baronial financial committee will review the request.
  - 3. If approved, contact the Quartermaster to arrange pickup and return.
  - b. Groups or individuals requesting the use of baronial equipment property are responsible for arranging transportation of the gear to and from the storage unit.

#### . The Quartermaster may sign out and transport equipment to and from events or meetings for others.

- d. While aA group may request the loan of baronial equipment, an individual from that group must takeproperty and takes responsibility for the equipmentproperty from when it is removed from storage until it is returned. That individualIt is expected to ensure that due care is taken with Baronial property protecting it from the elements as appropriate and trying to minimize any damage. The Quartermaster shall provide care instructions to the responsible individual for items being loaned.
- 6. e. When loaning equipmentproperty, the Quartermasterkey holder will ensure that the borrower has signed out the items using the master sign-out book, and will also complete two itemized lists of the property loaned one for the borrower and one for the Quartermaster's records. Event stewards should make their copy of the list available for event staff to use in repacking packing the equipmentproperty.
- f-The sign-out book and a current copy of the inventory will be stored inside the shed.
  - baronial storage. Everyone, including the Quartermaster, or any other officerkey holder, will
    sign out items before removing any item from the shed property-baronial storage. This includes
    removal for cleaning, rep air, la beling repair, labeling, etc.
  - 8. g. EquipmentProperty shall be returned to the shedbaronial storage within a week of the event using the itemized list and sign-out book. Upon return, the "Return Date" column of the sign-out sheet will be completed, and any necessary comments recorded. Exceptions to the one-week policy will be at the discretion of the Quartermaster.

- h. The individual who signed out the property is responsible for ensuring that all property is returned
- 10. i. For reasons of sanitation, maintenance and general courtesy, all equipmentproperty returned to the shedbaronial storage, especially feast gear and any other equipmentproperty involved in the preparation and serving of food or drink, must be cleaned and fully dry before its return.

#### 3. Storage

1. a. When storing items in the shedbaronial storage, items must be put back in their designated location. Shelves, wall hooks, etc. will be labeled to aid in re-storing things.

b. Consumable property is defined as property, which is used up through normal use; for example, duct tape, art supplies, paperpaper archery targets, twine, plastic bags, paperpaper plates, etc. The

inventory will clearly state when something is considered consumable, and the sign-out sheet has a column to reflect this.

#### e. If

#### **Use and Transport of Fighting Mats**

- The mats are kept in a storage facility with limited access hours. Anyone wanting to use the "shed" mats must contact the
  Nordskogen Quartermaster to arrange a date and time for pickup and return. At least two people capable of lifting and
  carrying the mats must meet at the storage facility to load and unload them.
- There are 17 mats. Nine are 8'x20'. There are 8 more mats in two different sizes 7'x16' and 7.5'x18'. When rolled up the mats are ~8.5'x12" diameter and weigh approximately 80 pounds each. The mats do not roll perfectly straight. While transporting the mats do not attempt to bend or fold the rolled-up mats. They will not bend or fold on the rolls.
- The total weight of the mats is ~1500 pounds.
- You need a 3/4-ton truck with an 8' bed or a trailer to haul them.
- Mats are to be used with the ridges up.
- When in use, the seams between the mats should be covered with tape. Four-inch tape is preferred over two-inch tape. You will use a bit less than two 60-yard rolls of tape.
- When rolling up the mats, make sure the flat side (non-ridged) is facing out as you roll the mats around the tubes. This
  makes the mats easier to stack and move.
- If you are using mats in the winter months, mats should be brought inside and rolled out on the floor for a half hour or so to allow the mats to warm up and flatten out. Flipping the mats over (ridges down?) so that they curl down will help this process.
- The tubes that the mats are wrapped around cost approximately \$17 each to replace if one is damaged.
- Please contact the Seneschal of Nordskogen in order to obtain permission to borrow the mats.
- According to Baronial Policy it is the responsibility of any group borrowing the mats to transport them to the event and
  back to storage in Nordskogen on a timeline agreed to with the Nordskogen Quartermaster before the mats are checked
  out. Nordskogen is not responsible for transporting the mats. Any damage to the mats is the responsibility of the group
  borrowing them.
- Nordskogen is not responsible for any vehicle damage incurred by hauling the mats.
- c. The baronial storage is a paid—for public storage facility or other location where the Barony is paying rent by the square or cubic unit, consumable property will not be stored there long term. Therefore, care should be taken to only store things that are in usable condition and that can be reused in the future.

Food or property with a known use-by datedate may not be kept in the shed-baronial storage. The event steward is c. responsible for distributing any such items left over from any event.

4. Maintenance

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- 1. a. Should any non-consumable item of Baronial property be damaged, lost or destroyed while on loan, the loanee will alert the Quartermaster of this and give details of the loss. Excessive losses will be reported by the Quartermaster to the general business meeting as p art of the event follow up process.
- b. The Quartermaster shall alert the Barony, via the general business meeting, to equipment property
  maintenance and replacement needs as they occur, including damage to or loss of non-consumable property
  while in storage

e. If Contact the Quartermaster with any questions about cleaning or maintenance to equipment is necessary but there is doubt as to the feasibility of the process (i.e., can these tabards be machine washed and dried?), contact the

Quartermaster to decide on methods before proceedingproperty. It is better to make slightly more work for the
Quartermaster than to replace items damaged by improper care.

d—If the borrower or Quartermaster has doubtdoubts whether an expensive, damaged item can be salvaged, the Quartermaster or the responsible party shall contact the Seneschal and the

4. Chancellor of the Exchequerbaronial financial committee for this decision. If an item is determined to be unsalvageable, it will be announced to the populace to give someone else an opportunity to find a use for the item.

#### III. IV...BARONIAL AWARDS

The Order of the Baronial Broom (OBB) is given to those who have given the Barony excellent service by performing that most disliked and most overlooked of tasks - cleaning up.

The Award of the Baton Gules (ABG) is the Barony's junior service order. It is given for service to the Barony. This award can be given more than once.

The Award of the Heliotrope (AH) is given for ability in the arts and sciences and for sharing that excellence with others, particularly by teaching. This award can be given more than once.

The Order of the Rouge Bend (ORB) is the Barony's senior service order. It is the only polling order in the Barony.

<u>The Order of the Silver Snowdrift (OSS)</u> may only be given to someone who has greatly benefited the Barony, and does NOT live within Nordskogen, or is NOT a member of the SCA.

The Order of the Heavy Cross is an award for those gentles that have given service to the Baronial College of Nordleigh. *This order is now closed.* 

The Order of the Azure Torch is an award for those gentles that have given service to the Canton of Tor Aerie. This order is now closed.

<u>The Award of the Prodigal Child</u> is for previous members of Tor Aerie returning to service after a long absence. <u>This order is now closed.</u>

The Award of the Azure Gauntlet (AAG) is given for notable prowess and level of participation within the Barony in a martial activity. This award can be given more than once for different martial pursuits.

<u>The Order of the Bronze Acorn</u> is an award for <u>those who for gentles</u> who have given service to the Baronial Canton of Nordleigh.

There is an award for gentles who have given service to the Baronial Canton of Blachemere. This item will be updated after the name officially <a href="passespasses">passes</a>.

Anyone may make recommendations for these orders at any time. <u>Direct written</u> Give written recommendations to the Baron and Baroness via the website form or email.

Drazhan Simonov and Áine ingen Máel Pátraic have lots of fun Thrown Weapons activities planned for most ages, levels of experience, and abilities and would love to see you! Whether you're enamored with axes and knives, seduced by spears or slings, or prefer plumbata, we'll have you covered. No experience is necessary and loaner equipment is available. (Please note: Northshield custom is to require closed-toed shoes on the thrown weapons range; please plan accordingly!)

We'd love to see you every day, and in order to encourage you to come visit, there will be a Thrown Weapons Progressive tourney again this year! "Travel" around Northshield to collect as many different stamps as possible for your passport!

You can throw up to 9 weapons per day (Thursday, Friday, Saturday), so come out to the thrown weapons range each day (Thursday, Friday, Saturday) for the most opportunity to collect stamps. Targets will be group heraldry from the active groups within the kingdom. For each group's heraldry that you score (knife, axe, spear, or sling), you will earn a stamp in your Kingdom Passport.

Prizes will be awarded for the Most Traveled (highest number of groups "visited"), Farthest Traveled (distance between the furthest groups "visited"), and Regional Rover(s) (those who "visit" at least two groups within one - and only one - of the Kingdom's regions.

#### Thrown Weapons At Night!

Come out to the WW Thrown Weapons range Thursday NIGHT (9:45-10:45 PM - after the archery night shoot!) for some after-dark adventures at the Shot in the Dark throw! Targets will be glow in the dark (glow sticks) - which make delightful splatter patterns when struck! This one is a lot of fun and present some unique opportunities to stretch yourself - can you strike based on target location alone?!

Axes and knives only. NO LOANER WEAPONS - THROW AT YOUR OWN RISK. Throwing in the dark represents potential for increased damage to weapons - especially wooden handles! Closed toe shoes are REQUIRED - glow sticks have small glass capsules inside them and darkness increases the potential for "finding" a weapon with your feet before your eyes.

Headlamps may be helpful for finding weapons that go wide but will not be allowed while participants are throwing from the line. Bug spray is HIGHLY recommended!

NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED by participants (photographers and on-lookers are allowed alcohol so long as they do not present a danger to the themselves or others). As always, the marshals have discretion to remove anyone from the field they believe may present a danger to themselves or others.

(Any assistance Friday morning to aid in clean-up will be welcome; careful adults and children willing to pick up the plastic bits around the targets will be helpful!)

#### Jousting at WW 28

For Warriors and Warlords 28 this year we are adding a foam jousting practice and ground crew session, Friday July 14 from 1-2:30pm. This will be for anyone and everyone interested in learning how to ground crew a joust tournament, especially those looking to assist with the tournament on Saturday from 11-12:30pm. (Great learning and service opportunity!) If you are simply curious how a joust tournament works, you are welcome to attend as well! We will have a unified meeting at the start with a brief overview of the guidelines for a proper SCA joust. http://www.florilegium.org/files/EQUESTRIAN/SCA-Jousting-art.htm

After this, ground crew and riders will split and have their specific talks and teachings with their marshal. We will be making passes against the quintain to work on lance targeting and technique. Armor is not required. This is considered a game and is open to ALL riders with a GAMES authorization. Give it a try. Breaking passes against the quintain may also be performed with a tournament lance. Ground crew will be resetting targets and handling lances during this phase as practice for them. Riders will also have the opportunity to make empty handed measuring passes in the tilt lane with each other to help desensitize the equines and prep them for the tournament.

Time permitting, properly armored riders with a JOUSTING authorization may make full breaking passes against each other. Any jousting authorization attempts will be run during this phase. PLEASE pre-arrange authorizations with me prior to the event so I can ensure there are time and horse available.

Loaner horses and lances will be available in limited quantities, comment or message me if you are in need. I will do my best to make arrangements.

I have ordered a carton of cardboard lance tubes. Equestrians, let me know if you are in need of any; \$3 each, keep them, take them home and use them for future events. I will be making and donating the foam tips for this event. Sound off here if you intend to participate in any form, for a preliminary head count.
