

Old Business

April Artisan Faire Update From Baron Gabriel Kjotvason

Went well; had fun. People liked it. Holding an event at the site—know where the toilet paper is. Could not access the stove so they did the cooking outside which went okay. Gate count: 82. People came in after that so probably 90-95 really. \$790 brought in, \$650 was the break-even point. This moot showed that it's easy for us to do small, single focused events. This event is a one off as far as Gabriel is concerned. Secret to a good event: find good people and trust them to do stuff.

Schützenfest Update From THL Tarien Dane

Four weeks out. Aside from feast, very confident. A third of the budget already paid for by pre-registration. Still talking to several folks about running feast. Have Marshalls in Charge for both archery and thrown weapons: Meistari Sefa Farmansdóttir and THL Aine ingen MaelPatraic. They are working on their shoots. Have one merchant, one thrown weapons class, one out-of-kingdom baron in court. Will need to go to the storage compartment for water coolers and such. Master Viði Hovdestad is bringing most of the archery stuff. Lord Lachlann: Can ask them for advance money as long as they have a good breakdown of what's being done.

New Business

Nell the Innocent asked about a possible Barony 50th Celebration at WW. Heliseus says that gaming night probably covers that. Might be something additional. That additional thing still being firmed up.

Trying to get a feast focused event in 2025. February? Jararvellir is asking if we'd be willing to co-sponsor this. If there's any martial arts that happen, there would be feasting themed prizes. Planning to include a breakfast bar, make-your-own soup for lunch and a 75 person very authentic feast. Olivet is probably not big enough, the Lord of Light kitchen too small. Nice to have the ability to have liquor at least discreetly. Jararvellir would mostly do the staff part but don't have a steward yet. Baroness Ekaterina Anastaseva suggests her church, Fairmount Ave. United Methodist Church in Saint Paul. Someone needs to look at the kitchen to see if it's suitable.

Meeting adjourned at 8:05 pm. Motion made by THL Judith and seconded by THL Tarien.

The Board of Directors is requesting commentary on proposed changes to Governing Documents proposed by the Society Marshal. These proposed changes aim to update the Governing Documents related to the Marshallate. The authorities, roles, responsibilities, and functions of the Marshallate occur in several sections of the Governing documents and have been added to or updated over the years. However, they do not fully reflect the breadth of current SCA martial activities and the evolution of our administrative and safety practices. These changes will (a) include all SCA martial disciplines, (b) incorporate the current and modern practices that have evolved over the years in our rules and the application thereof, and (c) ensure consistency throughout the several sections, while preserving the kingdom flexibility that enables the uniqueness of our kingdom cultures.

Governing Documents Commentary Request – Rules of the List Update —Deadline: June 10, 2024

The Board of Directors is requesting commentary on the changes to the Rules of the List proposed by the Society Marshal. These proposed changes aim to update the Rules of the List to include all SCA martial disciplines, while preserving their intent. Explanatory information is outlined for each rule with the functional change and the reason for the change provided where appropriate.

The Rules of the List are a critical core of SCA culture, values, and behavior. However, as written, they are mostly limited to Armored Combat and Rapier, and create contradictions for the approved martial activities of Equestrian, Combat Archery, Siege, Thrown Weapons, and Target Archery. The proposed changes also include a reordering of the list, to start with general underlying principles and then proceed to specific applications.

Commentary Request - Corpora Addition - Royalty Selection (Refusals)-Deadline: June 30, 2024

The Board of Directors is seeking feedback on the proposed addition to Corpora: Section IV.A, Royalty-Selection. A previous version was put out for comment in 2023. The majority of commentary received was favorable to the concept but not necessarily to the specific language. This rewritten proposal attempts to address those concerns. Additionally, principalities have been added to be in line with other rights, privileges, and restrictions of Principality royalty.

It is clearly stated in the Rules of the List in Corpora that all combatants must be acceptable to the Crown. This is an authority that has great importance in Royal Lists. It is also important to note that the Crown should not, whether intentionally or otherwise, attempt to influence the outcome a Royal List by using that authority. On multiple occasions a Crown has barred or attempted to bar a swath of people from competing in the Royal Lists based on factors such as geographical location, household affiliation, membership in a particular order, or simply rejecting well over half the letters of intent, giving the distinct impression that this action would control the outcome of the tourney. In 2022, the Society Seneschal issued a Corpora interpretation barring this practice which was upheld by the Board. This proposed language would add and define this restriction to Corpora directly, and also to require the Crown to state a reason to an individual to whom they have refused entry if the individual requests it.

Proposed language:

IV. ROYALTY

- 4. The Crown may refuse entry into the Royal Lists as either combatant or consort, on an individual basis only, for cause stated only to the person denied entry. Entry into the Royal Lists may not be denied to identifiable groups of people, or to a large enough number of entrants that it materially affects the size of the list.
- 5. The Coronet of a Principality may deny entry as stated above, only with the approval of the Crown.
