Schützenfest Update From THL Tarien Dane

This weekend. As far as he knows, everything is running smoothly and all is ready to go. Has been in touch with staff almost daily for about two weeks. Will receive passcodes Friday morning sand will meet Bob at about 3pm. No red flag warnings and none anticipated. We are the first renters of the season so there will be plenty of firewood! Toured the site last Sunday, everything is clean and ready to go. Everything in the kitchen works, power is on, there is a smoker out back. Expecting a warm weekend with showers late on Sunday.

Everyone is told to leave by noon. Our contract gives us until 2pm to be out. We can come a bit early at 3pm on Friday, volunteers at 4pm. Everyone else at 5pm. Please bring banners for the hall and blue painter's tape! We are paying just \$150 to have the porta potties there. \$100 of the savings from that have gone to Meistari Sefa Farmansdóttir for archery targets. Are about \$250 under budget. Have 57 pre-reg for food, 62 adult pre-reg and 5 minors. If 40 come in day of and chose to stay, should break even and maybe more. Space for about five more for the weekend meal plan. None of the lodgings are full. Open are 10 cabin spots, 6 yurt spots, 10-14 tent spots, 20+ lower program center.

Old Business (con.)

WW Update from Mistress Nell the Innocent and Baron Matthias of Rolling Oaks

56 days and 4 hours to WW! Pre-reg closes June 1. Pre-reg is prepaid. Group camping is watched over by the land mayor. (look up rules). So far, not as many merchants signed up as in the past. Reach out to your friends! Forms for pre-reg. and merchant sign-up are on the website. Firewood from outside Monroe County is illegal. This will be strictly enforced this year. Buy your firewood from the 4H. WW is requesting use of Nordskogen pavilion. Baroness Cynthia said yes. Master Viði Hovdestad usually transports is and they will check with him. It will be put it in the same Baronial camping space as last year. A Baronial court at WW is possible. Looking for volunteers to make a specific simple gift for the volunteers. Reach out to Mistress Nell if you'd like to help. Also need help from people who are warranted youth marshals and who have background checks to qualify to supervise other youth activities. Also reach out to Mistress Nell about this. The Kingdom Seneschal can help folks get background checks. They now have last year's event report. They are in the process of getting the signature cards updated. Alex and Aesa have worked together on this. Made a profit last year of \$8750 after the non-member surcharge was paid. Next step: a donation to Kingdom. Customarily, this is \$1 per attendee. Very conservative budgeting was done for 2024 so they can now add a few things. They will be getting some replacement poles for the carports, two new carport tops, plus one period shade fly for authentic encampment. More additions are to be phased in over the next two years. 550 adults attended. T-shirts brought in about \$2000. They made right decision when they decided not to raise fees. They are hoping to have the shower at WW this year and are working on its trailer. They are looking at replacing some of the equestrian equipment and getting some more seating in the shade. In the future, they want to make more benches. This year they will create a little shade space, an oasis between Info. Point and T-Shirt Sales. Next to straw boss, will create a mister setup. Info. Point will have electricity. There will be water coolers in the little shade space. Anne has some chairs to volunteer for the shade space. Put the Info. Point fruit in the oasis this year as an experiment?. Won't know the size of the oasis until set up actually happens.

Meeting adjourned at 8:22 pm. Motion made by THL Judith and seconded by Baron Geoffrey.

Governing Documents Commentary Request - Marshallate Content — Deadline: June 10, 2024

The Board of Directors is requesting commentary on proposed changes to Governing Documents proposed by the Society Marshal. These proposed changes aim to update the Governing Documents related to the Marshallate. The authorities, roles, responsibilities, and functions of the Marshallate occur in several sections of the Governing documents and have been added to or updated over the years. However, they do not fully reflect the breadth of current SCA martial activities and the evolution of our administrative and safety practices. These changes will (a) include all SCA martial disciplines, (b) incorporate the current and modern practices that have evolved over the years in our rules and the application thereof, and (c) ensure consistency throughout the several sections, while preserving the kingdom flexibility that enables the uniqueness of our kingdom cultures.

Governing Documents Commentary Request – Rules of the List Update —Deadline: June 10, 2024

The Board of Directors is requesting commentary on the changes to the Rules of the List proposed by the Society Marshal. These proposed changes aim to update the Rules of the List to include all SCA martial disciplines, while preserving their intent. Explanatory information is outlined for each rule with the functional change and the reason for the change provided where appropriate.

The Rules of the List are a critical core of SCA culture, values, and behavior. However, as written, they are mostly limited to Armored Combat and Rapier, and create contradictions for the approved martial activities of Equestrian, Combat Archery, Siege, Thrown Weapons, and Target Archery. The proposed changes also include a reordering of the list, to start with general underlying principles and then proceed to specific applications.

This change caused all references in the Governing Documents of the SCA, Inc. to "subscribing memberships" and requirements for immediate access to a newsletter at one's home to become obsolete. Commentary Request - Corpora Addition - Royalty Selection (Refusals)-Deadline: June 30, 2024

The Board of Directors is seeking feedback on the proposed addition to Corpora: Section IV.A, Royalty-Selection. A previous version was put out for comment in 2023. The majority of commentary received was favorable to the concept but not necessarily to the specific language. This rewritten proposal attempts to address those concerns. Additionally, principalities have been added to be in line with other rights, privileges, and restrictions of Principality royalty.

It is clearly stated in the Rules of the List in Corpora that all combatants must be acceptable to the Crown. This is an authority that has great importance in Royal Lists. It is also important to note that the Crown should not, whether intentionally or otherwise, attempt to influence the outcome a Royal List by using that authority. On multiple occasions a Crown has barred or attempted to bar a swath of people from competing in the Royal Lists based on factors such as geographical location, household affiliation, membership in a particular order, or simply rejecting well over half the letters of intent, giving the distinct impression that this action would control the outcome of the tourney. In 2022, the Society Seneschal issued a Corpora interpretation barring this practice which was upheld by the Board. This proposed language would add and define this restriction to Corpora directly, and also to require the Crown to state a reason to an individual to whom they have refused entry if the individual requests it.

Proposed language:

IV. ROYALTY

- 4. The Crown may refuse entry into the Royal Lists as either combatant or consort, on an individual basis only, for cause stated only to the person denied entry. Entry into the Royal Lists may not be denied to identifiable groups of people, or to a large enough number of entrants that it materially affects the size of the list.
- 5. The Coronet of a Principality may deny entry as stated above, only with the approval of the Crown.
