### TWELFTH NIGHT 2025 NEWS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

### Theme and Title for Our January 18, 2025 Event

Greetings members of Northshield. Our Nordskogen Business Meeting covered two important topics this past Wednesday. One, to review and revise the theme of Twelfth Night (previously, a Nordic Noel) and two, to discuss the standing title of the event; Twelfth Night. Due to the length and consideration both these topics deserve, we will be separating the discussion into two parts.

### Pt. 1

The theme Nordic Noel was brought to our attention as a concern, with the focus of the term Noel being overly focused on one religion, to the exclusion of others. Upon review, the word Noel has significant and current meaning to the Christian faith; specifically focusing on the birth of Jesus. This religious aspect does not accurately represent this year's theme and has been adjusted to Frosty Fete, to celebrate the Baroness' desire to see the symbol of the snowflake worn, adorned, and celebrated throughout the event.

We recognize the impact of the initial theme had on members of the Kingdom and want to apologize for the pain we have caused. The Baronesses of Nordskogen are appreciative of the opportunity to improve and solidify our overarching goal as a Barony; to have gatherings with historical premises that expand our horizons, celebrate milestones, or reflect particular historical objects / activities.

This also encouraged us to re-evaluate our efforts to keep and maintain an open dialogue. We plan on continuing our efforts to be accessible, seek to understand perspectives, and actively listen. #### Pt. 2

A second question arose during the discussion of this year's event theme, regarding the title Twelfth Night, and whether it should continue in use for future events. As many Scadians do, we conducted our research on the origin of the event title.

We found that the first Twelfth Night was held in the West Kingdom in 1967 and was specifically touted as being named for the Shakespearean play. The tradition spread as other Kingdoms emerged, and several local seasonal events throughout the Middle Kingdom adopted the name, including Nordskogen.

We did find a number of historical associations with the tradition of Twelfth Night. The Christmas closing feast, often irreverent, where it was tradition to remove holiday paraphernalia from the home the night prior to the Christian celebration of Epiphany. We found the celebration of Twelve days and nights at this specific time of year also has roots in Celtic and Norse traditions, such as the twelve days and nights of Pagan yule, and some Roman traditions of Saturnalia, where each of the twelve months of the year was represented by a day of festival. A few political bodies outlawed the celebration of Twelfth Night as overly secular by the late Middle Ages. The active celebration of Twelfth Night appears to have continued regionally into the early 1800s, but by the 1900s, had been largely discontinued.

With this history in mind, we asked our populace to join the conversation and share their thoughts.

Everyone expressed a strong commitment and desire to continue to improve inclusion, understanding that history and religion have intricate ties. The populace spoke eloquently, drawing from a variety of cultural and social experiences. Many of those who shared were concerned that excluding certain aspects of history, so long as they are not actively used as terms or symbols of modern religious practices, could devalue the opportunity to learn and fully appreciate the past we seek to re-create. It was also agreed that there are more active steps we can take to support the diverse members of the populace, and to keep an on-going and respectful conversation flowing to ensure an inclusive atmosphere. Based on the populace feedback, and with the inclusion of additional public acknowledgement that the title represents a specific approach to our study of the multi-faceted lens of history, we will keep the event title as Twelfth Night.

We feel that the title Twelfth Night, unlike Noel, is not currently exclusively tied to the modern observances of any specific religion and is instead largely associated with the anachronistic study of history, or Shakespeare's work. In addition, we will add the history and background of this title to the event website, as well as listing the other steps we will take to ensure our events are inclusive gatherings. This is an opportunity for everyone in our Kingdom to take a good look at past traditions, clarify how they include and celebrate everyone, and ensure they best serve the community we are today. For future assessments, we will recommend approaching with curiosity, seeking counsel, active listening, leading with kindness and maintaining paths of communication with the goal of inclusivity for the ultimate benefit of our community.

### Geoffrey De Charney Bear Pit Tourney: 11am until 2pm

In the spirit of Geoffrey De Charney and his book of chivalry: "qui plus fait, mieux vault," i.e., "he who does more is worth more." As such, our bear pit tourney will reflect this. The tourney will run from after morning court until 2pm. Take breaks as you wish but as long as the list is open in this time you can fight.

So you might be asking how will this tourney differ from a normal bear pit. Well let me tell you...

Anyone who fights deserves recognition for that and win or lose, they will get 1 point. The following points you also get win or lose depending on what you take out.

If you fight with great weapons you will get 1 additional point.

(This does not count bastard sword. If you fight bastard sword which is 4 feet in length or less, you get 2 points).

If you fight with sword and shield, no additional points as this is the norm.

If you fight 2 stick, you get 1 additional point.

If you fight buckler and sword with buckler no bigger than 18 inches diameter, you get 1 additional point.

If you win 3 fights in a row after the third step off, report your wins and weapon(s) you fought with and also that you won 3 in a row (which will be worth 1 additional point for that feat).

At the end of the tourney, whoever had the most fights gets 10 extra points as they have done more and therefore are worth more

As an additional item, whoever traveled the furthest will get 10 points. If multiple people have that in common, then they split the points but each will get at least 1 point. (If say, more than 12 people show up from the furthest spot, they all get 1 point but if 2 people did, they would each get 5).

### Single Elimination Tourney Ending to the De Charney Tourney: 2-2:30pm

At 2pm, we will add up points and the top eight people points wise will do a single elimination tourney to determine the ultimate winner. Any ties of points to determine the top eight will be resolved by serenade (this will be true in any and all ties). What does that mean? Well, it means that those tied will need to sing for their place. The list persons will determine who they believe was the best singer for each conflict. Songs do not need to be period but if you know a period song, singing that would get you more renown since one would imagine that, given we are in fact a medieval recreation group, those judging said song likely would take that into account.

Ideally, this tourney will give you many possible chances to show your stuff and shake up things enough that the normal suspects will struggle some unless they do more to be worthy of more.

### Ettin Tourney: 2:30pm until List close at 4pm

Two Chiv will be tied together in one large tunic and they will be a two headed Ettin. Each outside arm will have a weapon of the Ettin's choice. You must kill both Chiv to win. If you kill one, they are grounded to that spot and the dead half must stand still and is no longer a valid target but can spin in place. Legging the Ettin does not drop it to the ground but makes it limp on the first leg and if you get both legs, it is standing but immobile.

To keep with the theme of those who do more are worth more, there will be a choice in how you attempt to get points.

A win versus the Ettin is worth 6 points max. To get those points, you must use a bastard sword or single sword no shield and fight it alone.

However, you may choose to make a 2 person or 3 person team to fight said Ettin. If those teams win, then they split the points. A 2 person team win is 3 points each and if a 3 person team wins, each person gets 2 points. Each fighter will get at most 3 fights versus the Ettin (by yourself or in a team total of 3 fights). The highest point total wins and all ties in this tourney will be resolved via who had a better ratio of points to fights. If that also leads to a tie, we will do single rock, clock, Glaive (aka rock, paper, scissors).

**Descriptions Kittens and Lava** 

Youth combatants will cross a field of lava, rescuing as many kittens as possible, avoiding hazards and dragons. Points will be awarded for killing the dragon, number of rescued kittens, and successful navigation of the field.

(For those of you who haven't seen it, we have a tarp painted to look like stones with lava flowing between them. Combatants will cross the field by stepping from stone to stone. Kittens will be plush toys, not live kittens. Dragons are combatants who can walk on lava, but who are restricted to a zone halfway across the field. Dragons are typically Division 3 fighters or heavy weapons fighters with Youth Sparring authorizations.)

#### **Bear Pit for Youth**

In a bear pit tournament, after the combatants fight, the winner stays in the arena and the loser goes to the back of the line. Combatants wait in line until it is their turn to fight. In all youth combat, if one combatant is in Division 1 (age 6-9) the fight happens with Division 1 rules. If a Division 2 (age 10-13) combatant is fighting a Division 3 fighter, the fight happens with Division 2 rules.


